



Global - 20 Regional - 12 National - 7








4. UN Trust Fund: Financial Performance (as of 31 December 2018)

Distribution of Budgets across the 4 Pillars in the Trust Fund for Counter-Terrorism




Distribution of Expenditure in the UN Trust Fund for Counter-Terrorism





Top 5 contributors to the UN Trust Fund for Counter-Terrorism (since 2009)








