
... NOVEMBER TEMPERATURE AND PRECIPITATION OVERVIEW ...

Overall, much of November experienced well above average temperatures. It wasn't until the last week of the month that colder weather arrived. After a dry October, a few different storm systems brought beneficial rain and high elevation snow to northern Arizona. Nearly all of northern Arizona received above average monthly precipitation.

Nov. 3rd Funnel Cloud: Funnel Cloud reported in Joseph City. <u>Report Here</u>.

Nov. 2nd – 4th Rainfall: Widespread rain fell across northern Arizona with the heaviest amounts covering a portion of north central Arizona where 1 to 2 inches of rain fell. <u>Rainfall Reports</u> <u>Here</u>.

Nov. 16th Strong Wind: A passing, dry weather system brought increased wind to northern Arizona. <u>Wind Reports Here</u>.

Nov. 20th – 21st Rainfall: Another round of rain spread across northern Arizona with many areas receiving anywhere from 0.5 inch to 1.5 inches of rain. <u>Rainfall Reports Here</u>.
