Data from ground surveys in coordination with Garrett County Department of Emergency Management and the National Weather Service in Sterling, as well as radar data from the WSR-88D in Pittsburgh PA and Sterling VA confirm that a tornado of EF-1 intensity occurred in Asher Glade shortly before 8 PM on Saturday, May 11.

The first damage was noted just east of the West Virginia state line at approximately 7:55 PM near the intersection of Glade Road and Squire Fike Road. Dozens of trees were snapped and uprooted in a relatively narrow path (about 75 yards wide) in a convergent manner, indicating that the counter-clockwise rotation of the tornado was on the ground.

The tornado continued on a path east-southeast across MD-42 Friendsville Road to just east of the intersection of Buffalo Run Road and Myers Road. In this area, dozens of trees were also snapped and uprooted in a convergent manner. Radar data indicated rotation as well as a tornadic debris signature along this path.

This first tornado lifted with no additional tornadic damage (and no tornado debris signature on radar) noted for several more minutes to the east-southeast of this location, until a second tornado developed near Friendsville and Accident.
