

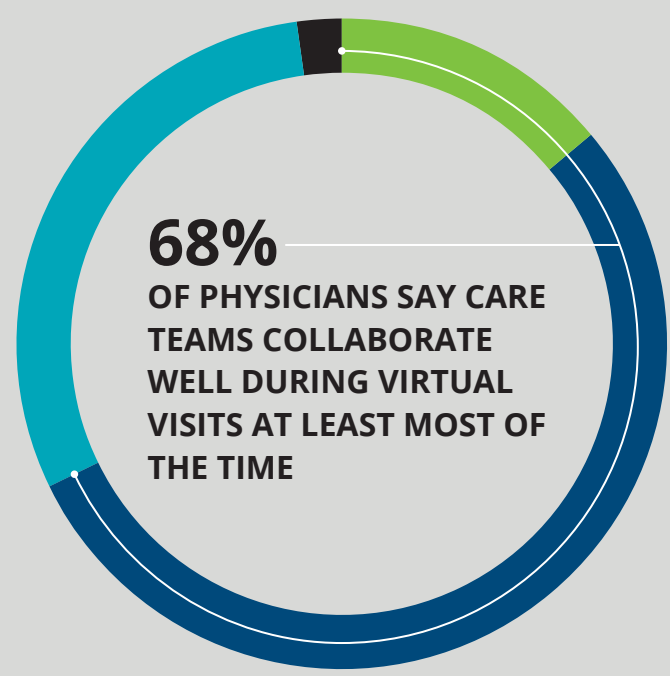
# OPPORTUNITIES TO EXPAND THE USE OF COMPREHENSIVE CARE TEAMS

## COMPREHENSIVE CARE TEAMS CAN BE HIGHLY COLLABORATIVE

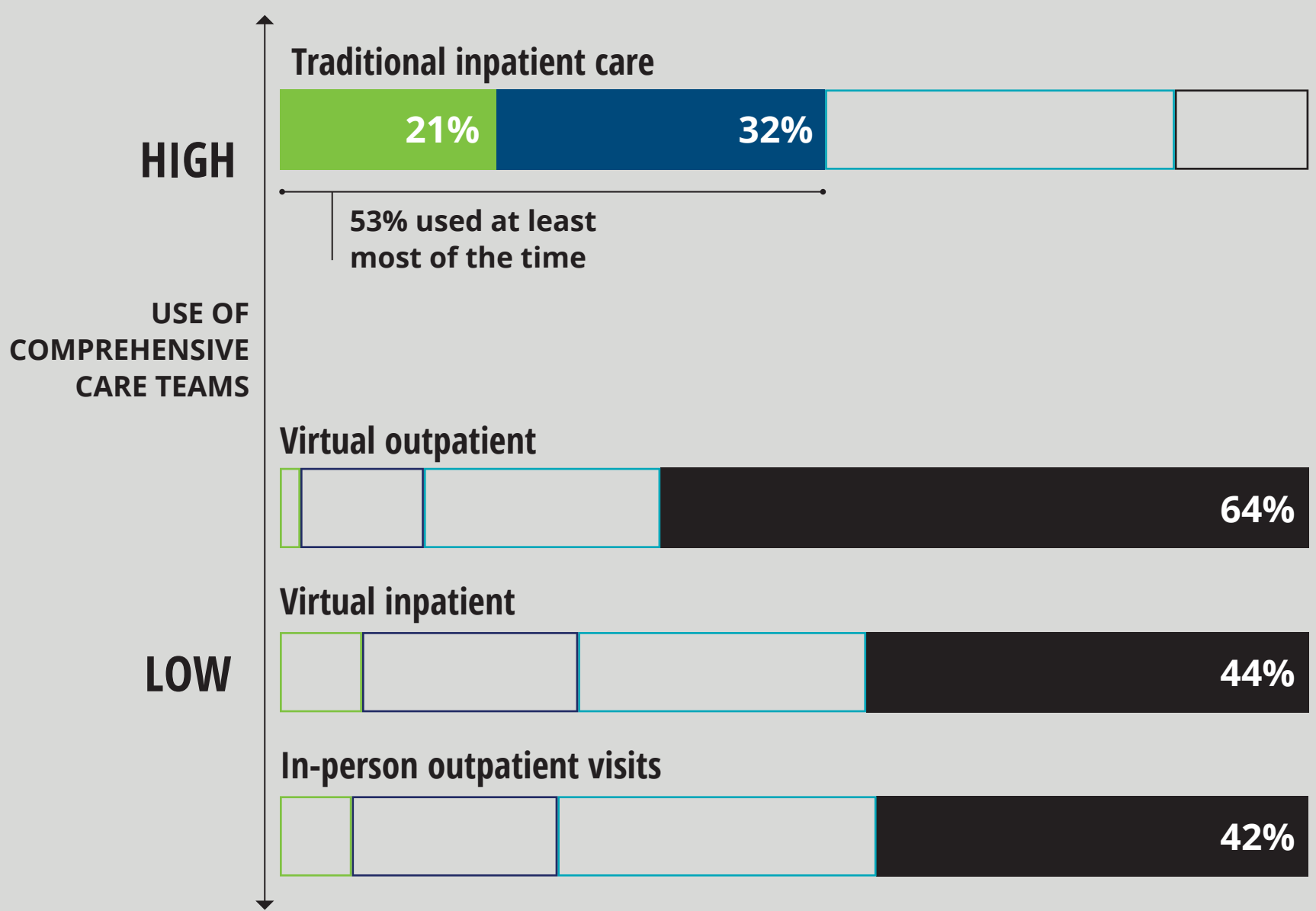

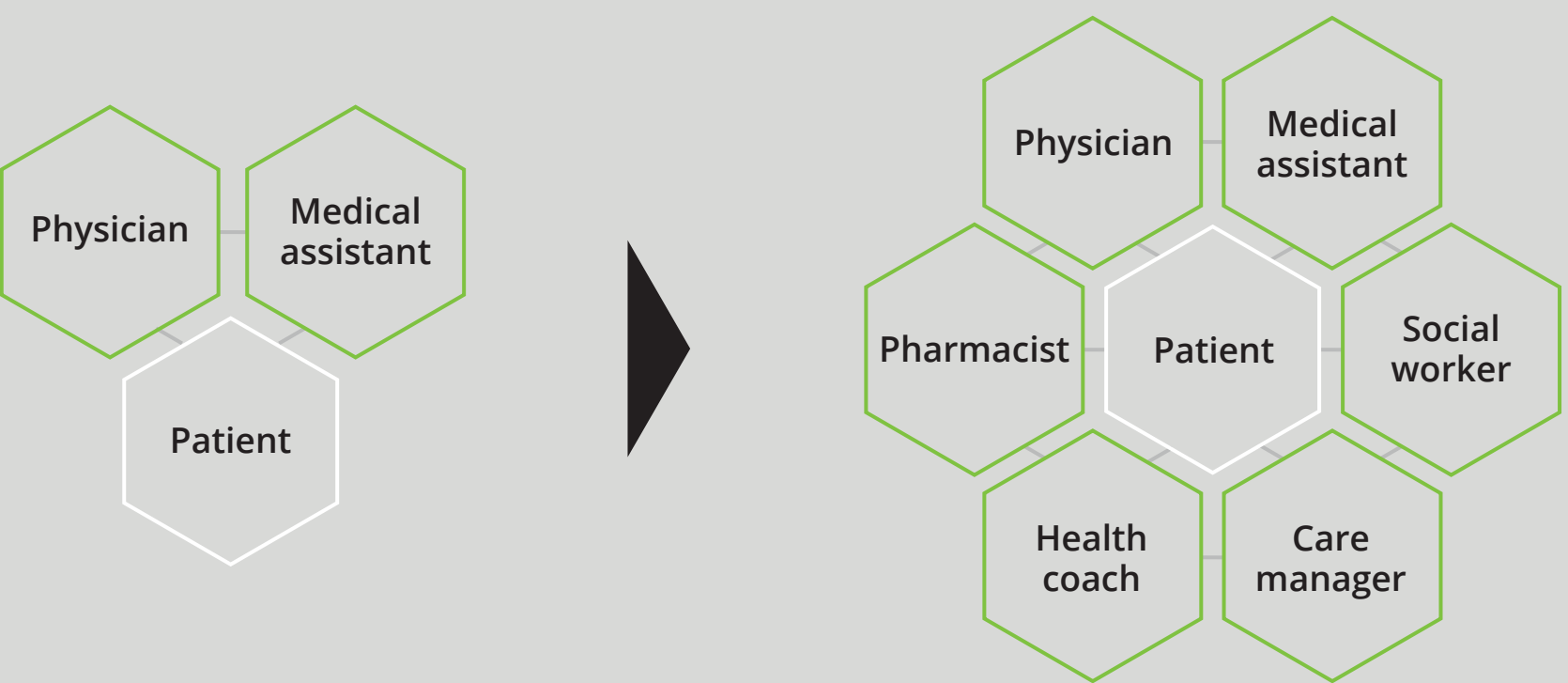
## YET, CURRENT UPTAKE OF COMPREHENSIVE CARE TEAMS IS LOW

## EVOLVING THE BASIC CARE TEAM INTO A COMPREHENSIVE CARE TEAM



Physicians say comprehensive care teams could improve care delivery and patient outcomes.

**37%** want social workers and behavioral health providers

**Benefit:**  
Better access to behavioral health

**34%** want community-based organizations that provide social services

**Benefit:**  
More equipped to address drivers of health

**31%** want care managers with strong clinical backgrounds

**Benefit:**  
Better care coordination and navigation, especially for clinically complex patients
