The Post Draft Issue grades a team's offseason a little differently than most. The grades we put into Power Sweep predict whether a team's record will improve or decline for the upcoming season. We take EVERYTHING into account. Included in the analysis are coaching changes, the NFL Draft, Free Agent signings, Free Agent losses and even favorable or unfavorable schedules. The "A" & "D" grades have been extremely accurate over the years. We spend a great deal of time and effort making these grades and while there was no list in '11 (work stoppage), here is a recap of the past 29 years as well as the record from the last 14 years with grades ('09, '10 & '12-'23).

Overview: While the Bills have strung together a 69-30 record the past 6 years, they have yet to make it to the Super Bowl. The Bills moved on from starting WR's Stefon Diggs and Gabe Davis. They did add Keon Coleman in the draft and signed 3 Free Agent WR's. QB Josh Allen is back and the Diggs trade may help the sideline and locker room eliminating some distraction. This is a team that has been and remains one of the NFL's elite teams and last year was +67.3 ypg which was 5th best in the NFL. Buffalo is in the middle of the road as far as our metrics go but after a dip to 11 wins last year they could improve on that total. The big question is can they FINALLY get past the other AFC blue bloods and reach their first Super Bowl since 1993.

Overview: Tua Tagovailoa was just 376 yards short of 5,000 and their 1-2 punch at running backs put up a combined 1,812 yds and 26 TDs. After putting together a winning record for the 4th straight year but last year found themselves in a frozen tundra at Arrowhead falling to the Chiefs in the playoffs. The Defense is the question mark of the team as they lose quality pieces but do add some depth. They do open up with three out of the first five at home then get to their bye week. Miami rates in the middle of our offseason metrics and were +83 ypg last year. In a division that features an outstanding Bills squad and a Jets team that appears to be vastly improved, we expect them to have another successful season.
