CARS PROJECT UPDATE

- Vendor responses for The Request for Information (RFI) were received on January 23, 2023. The team is currently reviewing the responses.
- Information has been gathered from additional states, the Fair Political Practices Commission and Federal Election Commission for the purpose of alternatives analysis.
- The project team plans to submit the S2AA to California Department of Technology for review and approval in February.



DIGITAL SIGNATURES IMPLEMENTATION

Beginning January 1, 2023, filers required by the Political Reform Act to file a report or statement by paper with the Secretary of State may instead file the paper report or statement by email.

Additionally, the requirement that an additional copy must accompany an original report or statement filed with the SOS in paper format has been eliminated.

Largest files received to date: 9.3 MB direct email, 23 MB in a zip file, 2,565 pages of campaign disclosure (Form 460).
