TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR CURRENT EXPENSES,
BUILDINGS, AND IMPROVEMENTS AT STATE INSTITU-
TIONS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
