

H. F. No. 1716: A bill for an act appropriating money to George V. Stennes and the Associates, Consulting Actuaries, for services rendered to the Interim Commission on Employee Retirement Systems.

H. F. No. 1730: A bill for an act authorizing the conveyance of certain state trust fund lands in Aitkin County.

H. F. No. 1753: A bill relating to the town of Van Buren in St. Louis County; providing for the transfer of certain moneys to other funds.

H. F. No. 1761: A bill relating to excise tax on gasoline and gasoline substitutes and providing that the county attorney shall prosecute violations; amending Minnesota Statutes 1961, Sec. 296.25, Subd. 1.

H. F. No. 1794: A bill authorizing the conveyance of certain real estate in which the state has an interest to the village of Roseville.

H. F. No. 1855: A bill relating to severance pay in the city of St. Paul; amending Laws 1959, Ch. 690, Sec. 3, as amended.

H. F. No. 2079: A bill for an act relating to civil defense; requiring the establishment of local civil defense agencies; amending Minnesota Statutes 1961, Secs. 12.02, Subd. 1; 12.25, Subds. 1 and 2.

H. F. No. 2081: A bill for an act relating to the Register of Deeds of St. Louis County fees for filing chattel mortgages, bills of sale, and related documents.

H. F. No. 2135: A bill for an act relating to maintenance, repair or replacement of private bridges or culverts across county ditches in Pennington County.
