Subject files of Irv Anderson, a Democratic-Farmer-Laborite who served as State Representative for Minnesota's 64, 64B, and 3A districts (Beltrami, Itasca, Koochiching, Lake of the Woods, and St. Louis counties) from 1964 through 1982 and 1991 through 2006. The files include correspondence, press briefings, articles, legislative bills, committee files, and related materials documenting his service, particularly his roles as Speaker of the House and Majority Leader, membership in the Democratic Legislative Campaign Committee, and interest in such topics as relations with Canada, caucus politics, economic development, mass transit, a weather station, and Voyageurs National Park.
