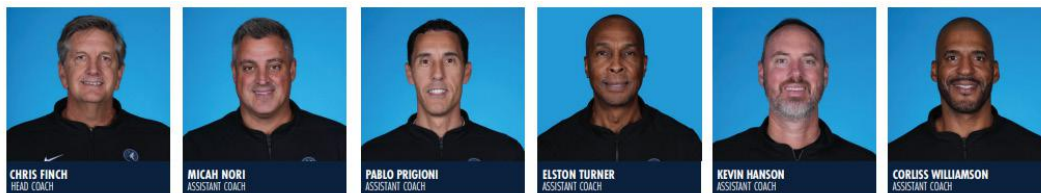

Game Recap

Karl-Anthony Towns finally found his rhythm, and the Timberwolves finally closed a game in the Western Conference finals. Now they head back to Minnesota to see if they can make things even more interesting against Dallas. Towns scored 20 of his 25 points in the second half and the Wolves held off the Mavericks 105-100 on Tuesday night to avoid a sweep. Anthony Edwards had 29 points, 10 rebounds and nine assists as the Wolves stayed alive in their first trip to the conference finals in 20 years, and just the second in the franchise's 35 seasons. Game 5 is Thursday night. Towns, who was shooting 28% from the field in the series coming in, was 9 of 13 from the field, including four of five from 3-point range. And that was after picking up fifth foul midway through the third quarter. Luka Dončić had 28 points, 15 rebounds and 10 assists in his sixth triple-double of these playoffs, but he and co-star Kyrie Irving were just 13 of 39 from the field. Irving, who was 14-0 in his career in closeout games coming in, made just one of six from long range and finished with 16 points. The Wolves have led in the final five minutes of the fourth quarter of every game in the series, and this time they finished. Towns put the Wolves ahead for good on a 3-pointer with 5:41 remaining, then hit another from deep the next time down. His third 3 of the final quarter put Minnesota up six with three minutes to go. "He was super confident," Edwards said. "He wasn't worried about any shots previous to the shots that he hit tonight. He played exceptionally well." Edwards put the Wolves up five with a jumper just inside the arc with 39 seconds left, and Minnesota hung on despite Edwards fouling Dončić on a made 3-pointer for a three-point Dallas deficit with 12 seconds to go. Dončić missed the free throw, and Naz Reid hit a bucket to push the margin back to five with 11 seconds remaining. The biggest sign of Towns' rhythm came in the third, when he scored 10 points in the first seven minutes before picking up his fifth foul for elbowing P.J. Washington Jr. in the face as Towns went up for a shot. The call against Towns prompted a technical foul against Minnesota coach Chris Finch from the second row, where he's been confined since the start of the second round of the playoffs because of a knee injury that required surgery. Assistant Micah Nari has been roaming the sidelines. Finch flirted with a second technical, which would have meant an ejection, a few minutes later when Edwards was called for his fourth foul going for a steal against Daniel Gafford. "To have him be on the sideline but behind the bench for the majority of these playoffs, you forget the impact he can have," said Mike Conley, who scored 14 points. "When your coach is up getting technicals and yelling and when you see him hobbling around to do it, it's impressive. It lit a fire on all of us." Towns fouled out in the final two minutes, while Edwards and Rudy Gobert, who had 13 points and 10 rebounds, finished with five apiece. "We weathered a lot of foul trouble out there, which was frustrating to say the least," Finch said. "Credit to our guys. They found a way to win the game. It was a lot like Games 1 and 2, and we were able to get it done tonight." The Wolves avoided being the 16th team out of 21 to get swept after losing the first three games of a series that started at home. Now they'll try to be just the fourth to force at least six games. Jaden Hardy scored 10 of his 13 points in a 3:38 stretch that spilled into the first bucket of the fourth quarter, a corner 3 that pulled Dallas within two. Four of the game's 11 lead changes came in the fourth. The Mavs were without rookie center Dereck Lively II, who injured his neck when Towns accidentally knicked him in back of the head in Game 3. Maxi Kleber, who has been out since May 3 with a separated shoulder, returned to give Dallas another option inside. But Daniel Gafford didn't have his regular tag team partner as a rim protector at center, and the Wolves shot a series-best 53% from the field.

Game Recap

Luka Dončić lunged for the ball after a steal by Anthony Edwards, knocking it far enough away to create a scramble and a jump ball the Dallas superstar won. The Mavericks made all the big plays again — on both ends of the court — and are a win away from their first trip to the NBA Finals in 13 years. Dončić and Kyrie Irving scored 33 points apiece and Dallas put together a decisive run in the final five minutes to beat the Minnesota Timberwolves 116-107 on Sunday night for a 3-0 lead in the Western Conference finals. The 14-3 finish gave the Mavs a fifth consecutive playoff victory after Dereck Lively II left with a sprained neck when the rookie center took an accidental shot to the back of the head from Karl-Anthony Towns' knee. P.J. Washington Jr., who scored 16 points, put Dallas ahead for good on a tiebreaking corner 3-pointer with 3:38 remaining after Dončić passed to Irving, who sent the ball to Washington. The co-stars took over from there. Dončić hit a shot in the lane for a four-point lead, Irving sent the crowd into a frenzy on a falling-down jumper and Dončić found Daniel Gafford for an alley-oop dunk and a 113-105 lead with 34 seconds left. Gafford had just blocked Mike Conley's layup attempt at the other end. Edwards had 26 points for the Wolves, but just four after scoring eight consecutive points for Minnesota to get the Wolves even in the third quarter. "I never think the sky is falling," Edwards said. "I'm always positive, always happy. Been through the works, so the sky's never falling for me." Towns scored 14 points but missed all eight 3s, including a rushed 27-footer early in the shot clock when the deficit was four with 1:25 remaining. After taking a 104-102 lead on Kyle Anderson's floater with five minutes to go, Minnesota — which couldn't hold leads of 18 points in the first half and five points in the final 90 seconds of Game 2 — missed seven consecutive shots. "You've got to try to score alongside of them," Wolves coach Chris Finch said. "The whole series, we've struggled to close games. These three-minute games that we're playing, we're losing." Dončić, whose game-winning 3-pointer in the final seconds of Game 2 in Minnesota put Dallas firmly in control of the series, was 10 of 20 and 5 of 11 from deep. Irving, who won the 2016 title alongside LeBron James with Cleveland, scored 14 points in the fourth quarter and finished 12 of 20 and 3 of 6 from long range. The Mavs, with 2011 NBA Finals MVP Dirk Nowitzki watching from center court, are the closest they've been to the NBA's biggest stage since the big German led them to their only championship. Edwards was 11 of 24, but took just three shots in the fourth quarter, making two. The 22-year-old star who has acknowledged fatigue in the series had nine rebounds and nine assists. "We can't be anything but positive at this point," Edwards said. "We can't be negative. Try to get one win at a time." In the second quarter, Lively absorbed the kind of contact normally found on football fields not far from Kansas City Chiefs stars Patrick Mahomes and Travis Kelce, the quarterback-tight end pair sitting courtside. The rookie from Duke stayed on the court holding his head after it snapped forward on the accidental contact. Lively was down for several minutes before appearing dazed as he was helped off the court and taken to the locker room. Lively fell as Mike Conley, who scored 16 points, was driving for a missed shot, and Towns was pursuing an offensive rebound when his knee hit Lively's head in the second quarter. The 20-year-old Lively and Gafford, the starter, played a big role in helping Dallas take a 2-0 lead. Lively is 12 of 12 from the field in the series, including three makes in Game 3.

WESTERN CONFERENCE FINALS, GAME 2: FRIDAY, MAY 24, 2024 - MINNEAPOLIS, MINNESOTA



Game Recap

Luka Dončić searched to find space as the clock ticked down, using a screen to draw Defensive Player of the Year Rudy Gobert out to the top of the key and a crossover dribble to set up his step-back 3-pointer. With a swish and a shout, Dončić and the Dallas Mavericks are headed home with a 2-0 lead in the Western Conference finals on the Minnesota Timberwolves. Dončić hit the winner with 3 seconds left and posted his fifth triple-double of the playoffs to lead the Mavericks to a 109-108 victory over the Timberwolves on Friday night. Dončić hit 32 points, 13 assists and 10 rebounds for his eighth triple-double in 42 career postseason games for the Mavericks, who erased an 18-point deficit that stood late in the second quarter and were still down 16 midway through the third. Naz Reid went 7 for 9 from 3-point range for 23 points, but his last try at the buzzer rimmed in and out to send the Wolves to Dallas for Game 3 on Sunday in a big hole after another off night by stars Anthony Edwards and Karl-Anthony Towns. “First to four. Nothing’s won,” Dončić said. “You’ve just got to think about next game — not in the future, just this game.” Kyrie Irving had 13 of his 20 points in the fourth quarter, including a corner 3-pointer with 1:05 left that pulled the Mavericks within two. Then the Wolves sandwiched turnovers around a short miss by Dončić. Edwards threw the ball out of bounds off a drive with 13 seconds left, setting up Dončić’s winner. He took the inbound pass and dribbled to set up a screen by Dereck Lively II that triggered a switch by the Wolves, with NBA All-Defensive second team pick Jaden McDaniels dropping with Lively’s roll and Gobert staying out on the top of the key. “I can’t move fast, but I can move faster than him,” said Dončić, who flexed his arms and yelled at Gobert, who fouled him hard at one point in the first half to draw a stare from the five-time All-NBA pick. The lead for either side was three points or less from 10:50 remaining to 1:29 until Edwards — who had 21 points but is shooting 11 for 33 in the series — sank two free throws for a 108-103 edge. That came right after Irving missed both foul shots that had the crowd howling for the promotion that awards fans a free Chick-fil-A sandwich. Mike Conley scored 18 points and Gobert had 16 points and 10 rebounds for the Wolves, who needed Reid — the NBA Sixth Man of the Year — more than ever. His top-of-the-key swish at the end of the third quarter gave the Wolves an 86-79 cushion just after the Mavericks closed the gap hard with a 21-7 spurt — mostly while Conley rested — over a 6:36 stretch. “We’re just beating ourselves a lot of the times, making simple, mental errors,” said Towns, who had 15 points on 4-for-16 shooting. “Our defense that’s held us together all year, sometimes it just falters in the wrong times. If you mix that in with the offense that we’re just not producing right now, it’s tough.” Dončić, who flourished in the fourth quarter of Game 1 to finish with 33 points, has been fighting through what the Mavericks have listed on the league’s official injury report as a sprained right knee and left ankle soreness. When he was subbed out late in the first quarter, Dončić jogged straight to the locker room before returning to the bench prior to his next shift. After running the floor for a fast-break layup late in the second quarter, Dončić was laboring and limping on the way back. He shot 5 for 14 before halftime. The beauty of the 25-year-old Slovenian superstar’s game is that he hardly needs a full-strength spring in his step to dominate. Dončić had Minnesota’s league-leading defense looking out of sorts on so many possessions with his laser-like passing, often setting up their high-leaping centers Daniel Gafford (16 points) and Lively (14 points) with slick lobs for easy dunks. The Mavericks shot 60.5% from the floor (23 for 38) in the second half. “Luka was definitely involved in a lot of that. He makes a lot of great reads out of the pick-and-roll. We tried to show him different looks,” Edwards said.

Game Recap

Luka Dončić led a strong finish for the Dallas Mavericks, swishing crucial shots down the stretch, drawing a couple of fouls and even playing strong defense. The Mavericks might not be the favorites in yet another series, but they stole home-court advantage from the Minnesota Timberwolves with this promising start. Dončić had 15 of his 33 points in the fourth quarter and Kyrie Irving scored 24 of his 30 in the first half to lift the Mavericks to a 108-105 victory over the Timberwolves in Game 1 of the Western Conference finals on Wednesday night. Dallas had a 62-38 advantage in points in the point to offset a 6-for-25 shooting performance from deep. “We made important ones,” said Dončić, who scored seven straight points over 63 seconds early in the fourth quarter to fuel a 13-0 run by the Mavericks for a 97-89 lead. The Mavericks trailed 102-98 after a 3-pointer by Anthony Edwards with 3:37 left, before an 8-0 run the Wolves didn’t stop until a tip-in with 10.5 seconds to go. For the first time in six tries under coach Jason Kidd, the Mavericks won the first game of a playoff series. Jaden McDaniels had his third straight 20-plus-point game with 24 points for the Wolves, but Edwards — who earned his first All-NBA selection prior to the game, on the second team — was stifled for 19 points in a team effort from the Mavericks. Karl-Anthony Towns needed a late burst to get to 16 points and finished 6 for 20 from the floor. The star power in this series is strong, and for the first night at least the Mavericks got what they needed from their leading duo while the Wolves largely struggled to run the offense around theirs. “Terrible offense down the stretch: bad shots, turnovers, no composure,” Wolves coach Chris Finch said. “We’ve got to be better in clutch moments.” Towns came to life with a long jumper, a lob to Rudy Gobert for a slam and a 3-pointer on a 2-minute burst to give the Wolves the lead back with 4:39 to go on the way to a 10-0 run that Dončić ended with a 3-pointer. P.J. Washington, who had 13 points and seven rebounds, hit from deep to put the Mavericks back in front with 1:56 to go. Towns thought he tied the game with a putback dunk on the next possession, but that was waved off for basket interference. Minnesota hosts Game 2 on Friday night. Edwards, who went scoreless in the third quarter, added 11 rebounds and eight assists. “He’s an amazing player. We have to put multiple bodies on him,” Dončić said. “If he’s going 1-on-1, it’s kind of tough to stop him.” Naz Reid had 15 points and Kyle Anderson added 11 points off the bench for the Wolves, who had two days off after dethroning defending champion Denver with a Game 7 comeback from a 20-point deficit to win the second-round series. The transition was sharp from the Nuggets and NBA MVP Nikola Jokić’s deliberate and powerful style to the pick-and-roll-heavy Mavericks, who frequently lost their opponents off screens for wide-open dunks. They moved with a purpose that kept the Wolves from consistently setting their half-court defense around the NBA Defensive Player of the Year Gobert at the rim. Irving’s stunning burst on the break and on the drive presented a unique challenge the Wolves and their league-leading defense didn’t face in the last round, when they held the Nuggets to an average of 85 points over their four wins. “He got us going. Without him, we would probably be down 20 at halftime,” Dončić said. “I had to help him in the second half a little bit. So we switched roles this time.” McDaniels, who played his usual relentless defense on the perimeter, was the catalyst on the other end of the court too with five 3-pointers in the first half, but Towns had trouble getting shots to fall and Edwards found his driving lanes constantly clogged. The Mavericks have cranked up their defense since adding Daniel Gafford and Washington at the trade deadline, as top-seeded Oklahoma City can attest after losing in six games in the last round. Dončić chipped in, too, breaking up a lob from Mike Conley to Gobert for one of his three steals with 1:06 remaining and the Mavericks leading by two. “No one panicked. There was just a lot of trust, no matter how bad or how good we’re playing,” Kidd said.

REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS

The Wolves' Game 4 win in Dallas on May 28 marked their third win this postseason when facing elimination, the most such wins in a single postseason in franchise history.

With their Game 4 win, Minnesota improved to 6-2 on the road in this year's playoffs. Entering this postseason, the franchise had a total of six road wins in the postseason (6-27).

ALL FIVE TO STAY ALIVE

Game 4 in Dallas marked the fourth time this season all five of the Wolves starters have scored in double figures. Minnesota improved to 3-1 this postseason when all five starters score 10+ points.

A GAME 7 WIN FOR THE AGES

With their Game 7 win in Denver, the Timberwolves moved to 2-0 in franchise history in Game 7's and advanced to the Western Conference Finals for just the second time in team history. The Wolves trailed by as many as 20 points before coming win, marking the largest comeback in a Game 7 in NBA Playoff history.

After trailing 53-38 at halftime, the Timberwolves came back to win Game 7 in Denver. Prior to tonight, the largest lead a team had come back from in a Game 7 in NBA Playoff history was 11 (2X; MR: May 28, 2018; Golden State at Houston).

The Timberwolves are the first team in NBA Playoff history to win a seven-game series after winning the first two games on the road, losing the next three games and winning the last two games.

Minnesota outscored Denver by 28 points in the second half, marking the second largest point differential in any half in a Game 7 in NBA Playoff history (May 15, 2022; 30 points – first half; Dallas at Phoenix).

THE TWO BEST WORDS IN SPORTS...

After their Game 6 win, the Timberwolves are headed to their second Game 7 in franchise history (May 19, 2004, vs. Sacramento). The May 16 win at Target Center vs. Denver marked the franchise's first Game 6 victory after previously going 0-4.

DRAWN AND QUARTERED

Minnesota held Denver to just 14 points in the first quarter of Game 6, in what was the fewest points the Nuggets scored in a single quarter all season (regular and postseason).

The Wolves closed the Nuggets out by holding them to just nine points in the fourth quarter, outscoring Denver 29-9 in the final frame. Denver's nine points were tied for the fewest points in a single quarter in a playoff game by a Timberwolves opponent in franchise history (April 21, 2004 vs. Denver; second quarter) and tied for the fewest points scored in a single quarter in a playoff game in Nuggets franchise history.

The 20-point fourth quarter point differential is the largest in any quarter in Timberwolves franchise playoff history.

30 DIMES FROM THE DENVER MINT

Led by Anthony Edwards' playoff career-high nine assists, the Timberwolves recorded 30 assists for the first time in this postseason in Game 5 at Denver. It marked just the third time in franchise playoff history the Wolves have recorded 30+ assists and the first time doing so since recording a franchise playoff record 32 assists on April 16, 2022, at Memphis.

MINNESOTA GUNSLINGERS

For the second consecutive game and the fifth time this postseason, the Timberwolves shot 50.0%+ from the field in Game 4 in Dallas. In shooting 52.7% (39-of-74) from the field, Game 4 marked their highest shooting percentage of this year's playoffs and the third highest shooting percentage in franchise postseason history. The last time the Wolves shot better than 52.7% from the field in a postseason game was April 22, 2003 (vs. Los Angeles Lakers; 55.6%, 40-of-72).

PAINT BEASTS

For the second consecutive game and eighth time this postseason, Minnesota outscored their opponent in the paint, besting the Mavericks 46-36 down low in Game 4 in Dallas. The Timberwolves are 7-1 this postseason when outscoring their foes in the painted area.

A TEAM EFFORT

Game 7 in Denver marked the third time in this year's playoff that all five Timberwolves starters scored 10+ points.

Game 7 also marked the fourth time this postseason Minnesota had at least six double-digit scorers in a game. The Wolves had never had more than two such games in a single playoff run before 2024.

WE FOUND A WAY TO WIN

Despite shooting just 39.2% from the field against the Nuggets, the Wolves pulled out a Game 7 victory. It was the lowest shooting percentage of any team to win a Game 7 since 2020 (Sep. 1, 2020; Denver vs. Utah: 37.3%) and the lowest of any road team to come away victorious in a Game 7 since 2012 (May 13, 2012; LA Clippers at Memphis: 38.5%).

EATERS OF THE GLASS

Minnesota outrebounded Denver 62-43 in Game 6, marking the Wolves most rebounds in franchise playoff history and the first-time grabbing 60+ rebounds in a playoff game.

Led by Gobert and Towns, who each grabbed seven rebounds in the first quarter, the Wolves grabbed 19 boards in the opening frame. Their 19 rebounds were the most in any quarter in this year's playoffs and it marked the first time in franchise postseason history two teammates each pulled down 7+ rebounds in a single quarter.

45 TO STAY ALIVE

In winning Game 6 vs. Denver 115-70, the Wolves tallied their largest margin of victory in franchise playoff history. The Timberwolves 45-point win marked the biggest win against a defending champion in NBA Playoff history.

The Nuggets' 70 points marked the fewest points by a Timberwolves opponent in franchise playoff history and the fewest points scored in a playoff game in Denver's franchise playoff history. Game 6 marked the first time a team had been held to 70 points or less in an NBA Playoff game since April 16, 2016 when the Dallas Mavericks were held to 70 points by the Oklahoma City Thunder.

Denver's 26 made field goals were the second fewest by an opponent in Wolves franchise playoff history.

In holding Denver to just 30.2% (26-of-86) shooting from the field, it marked the lowest shooting percentage by a Wolves opponent in franchise playoff history. It also marked the Nuggets' lowest shooting percentage in franchise playoff history.





2-0 IN FAVOR OF THE CHALLENGER

With their Game 2 win in Denver, The Timberwolves took a 2-0 series lead have now won six consecutive playoff games, the longest streak in team history. The Timberwolves previous record for most consecutive playoff wins was two. The Wolves have also tied the NBA Playoff record for most consecutive wins to start a playoff run for a three-seed, tying the 2004 San Antonio Spurs and the 2020 Boston Celtics.

10+ BLOCKS/10+ STEALS

Minnesota finished Game 2 in Denver with 11 steals, marking the 13th time in franchise playoff history the Wolves collected 10+ steals. The Timberwolves also finished the night with 12 blocks, marking a franchise playoff-high and the third time the team rejected 10+ shots in a playoff game. Tonight marked just the second time in franchise history that the Wolves tallied 10+ steals and 10+ blocks in a playoff game.

THREE-SEED STREAKING

The Wolves six straight wins to start the playoffs are tied for the most consecutive wins to start a playoff run by a three seed in NBA history, tying the 2004 San Antonio Spurs and 2020 Boston Celtics.

GAME WON - ROUND TWO

With their Game 1 win in Denver on May 4, the Timberwolves have won a franchise-best five consecutive playoff games following their first-round sweep of the Phoenix Suns. The May 4 win also marked the second time in franchise history the team won a Game 1 on the road (April 16, 2022, at Memphis).

DOWN LOW DAWGZ

Minnesota outscored Denver 52-42 in the paint in their Game 1 victory in Denver. The Nuggets outscored the Timberwolves in all four of the team's regular season matchups (186-216). The Wolves have now outscored their opponents down low in four of their five playoff games this season.

THAT'S A SWEEP!

With their Game 4 win in Phoenix on April 28, the Timberwolves swept the Suns, the first time in franchise history completing a four-game sweep and the first time winning a playoff series since 2004. It is the first four-game sweep in a best-of-seven series in Minneapolis sport's history.

DOWN BUT NOT OUT

After trailing 61-56 at the half of Game 4 in Phoenix, the Timberwolves came back to win, marking the first time in franchise history they have come back to win a playoff game on the road after trailing at halftime (1-21).

DEFENSIVE DOGS

In holding the Nuggets to just 80 points in Game 2, the Timberwolves held Denver to their fewest points scored this season in either the regular or postseason. It marked the second consecutive time holding the Nuggets under 100 points and the fourth time doing so this season including regular season and playoffs. No other team held Denver under 100 points more than once.

Denver's 80 points are tied for the fourth-lowest point total for an opponent in franchise playoff history and the lowest playoff opponent point total since holding the Lakers to 71 points on May 23, 2004.

COMFORTABLE AWAY FROM HOME

With their Game 2 win in Denver, Minnesota became the 34th team in NBA history to win both Game 1 and Game 2 of a best-of-seven playoff series on the road. Of the previous 33 teams that did so, 28 went on to win the series.

Additionally, the Wolves are now the sixth Western Conference team since 2000 to win their first four road playoff games. Of the previous five teams to do so, four went on to win the NBA Finals.

DID YA'LL FORGET ABOUT OUR D?

In holding the Nuggets to 99 points, Game 1 in Denver marked the first time during the 2024 NBA Playoffs the Nuggets failed to reach 100 points. Including the regular season, the Timberwolves have now held the Nuggets under 100 points in all three of their wins against Denver this year. The Nuggets were held under 100 just eight times during the 2023-24 regular season, the Wolves were the only team to do so twice. Minnesota has held their opponents under 100 points three times during this year's playoffs.

BUILDING A LEAD A MILE HIGH

The Wolves led by as many as 32 points in Game 2 at Denver, the biggest lead in franchise playoff history.

The Timberwolves led 61-35 at halftime of Game 2, marking the largest halftime lead on the road against a defending champion since the Cleveland Cavaliers led the Chicago Bulls 59-33 in the Eastern Conference Finals on May 21, 1992.

DID SOME ONE SAY SECOND HALF HOT DOGS?

The Wolves shot 71.1% (27-of-38) in the second half of Game 1 at Denver, the best field goal percentage in a half of a road playoff game since the San Antonio Spurs shot 75.8% (25-of-33) in the first half at the Miami Heat in Game 3 of the 2014 NBA Finals.

SURRENDER NO LEAD

The Wolves never trailed in their Game 3 victory over the Suns, marking just the third wire-to-wire playoff win in franchise history.

Anthony Edwards finished the 2023-24 season averaging a career-high 25.9 points, 5.4 rebounds and a career-high 5.1 assists on the season, becoming the first player in franchise history to average 25+ points/5+ rebounds/5+ assists; Edwards is one of eight players in the NBA this season to do so.

His 25.9 points per game is the third-highest points per game average in franchise history. Edwards is just the third player in franchise history to average 25+ points per game, joining Kevin Love (2X; MR: 2013-14) and Karl-Anthony Towns (2016-17).

IRON MAN NICKEIL

Nickeil Alexander-Walker started 20 games this season and appeared in all 82 games, averaging 8.0 points on 43.9% shooting, including 39.1% from deep, 2.0 rebounds and a career-high 2.5 assists per contest. Alexander-Walker also made a career-high 131 threes this season.

Alexander-Walker is one of 17 players in the NBA to play in all 82 games this season and became the 37th player in franchise history to do so. Taj Gibson and Tyus Jones were the last Timberwolves to do so in the 2017-18 season.

THE DEFENSIVE ANCHOR - RUDY GOBERT

Rudy Gobert played in and started in 76 games this season, the fourth-most appearances in his career and the most games played since he appeared in 81 games in the 2018-19 season.

Gobert averaged 14.0 points, 12.9 rebounds and 2.13 blocks per contest. His 2.13 blocks were his most blocks per game since 2020-21 (2.68 BPG) and he attempted 614 shots, the second most shot attempts of his career (2016-17: 625 FGA). Gobert averaged 34.1 minutes per game, the second time in his career he played 34+ minutes per night (2019-20: 34.3 MPG).

Gobert finished the 2023-24 campaign with 54 point/rebound double-doubles, the 15th time in franchise history a player finished with 54+ point/rebound double-doubles. Gobert joins Kevin Garnett, Kevin Love, Al Jefferson, and Karl-Anthony Towns as the only players in franchise history to do so. Gobert also tallied 38 double-doubles with at least two blocks this season, the second most such games in franchise history in a single season, trailing only Kevin Garnett's 2003-04 season (47 games).

MINNESOTA MIKE AGES LIKE DICK CLARK

Mike Conley finished the season averaging 11.4 points on 45.7% shooting, including a career-high 44.2% from deep, 2.9 rebounds, 5.9 assists, 1.16 steals and a career-low 1.3 turnovers per game. His 45.7% field goal percentage was the second-highest in a single season in his career (2016-17: 46.0%).

Conley tallied 15 games this season with 15+ points on 4+ made-threes, becoming just the 12th player in NBA history aged 36 or older to tally 15+ games with 15+ points and 4+ made threes. His 15 such games are the most in franchise history.

Conley is just the eighth player in NBA history (since 1967-68) aged 36 or older to shoot 44.0%+ from beyond the three-point line in a single season (min. 100 3PA). This season, when Minnesota makes 12+ threes in a game, fans were eligible to receive a free Classic Beef 'N Cheddar from Arby's.

On April 10 in Denver, the Wolves shot 13-of-30 from the three-point line against the Nuggets, their 51st game this season in which they have made 12+ threes. The Wolves went 35-16 when making 12+ threes.

On April 3 vs. Toronto, Minnesota shot 20-of-43 from deep, the fourth time this season the Wolves made 20+ shots from deep. Minnesota is 18-3 all-time when knocking down 20+ shots from beyond the three-point line.

The Timberwolves made 15+ threes 16 times, going 12-4 when doing so.

ANOTHER 20-POINT COMEBACK

After trailing by 21 points at the 1:04 mark in the first quarter against the Wizards on April 9, the Timberwolves stormed back to win. It marked their second 20+ point comeback win of the season, marking the first time in franchise history the Wolves have had multiple 20+ point comebacks in the same season. It was Minnesota's 14th 20+ point comeback victory in franchise history.

WE'RE GOING BACK-TO-BACK

This season, the Timberwolves will play in a total of 13 back-to-back sets: three home-home, five away-away, one home-away and four away-home. To this point in the season, Minnesota is 10-4 in back-to-back sets, 5-2 in both the first and second games. The Wolves swept their third consecutive back-to-back set with a 121-100 win in Los Angeles against the Clippers on Feb. 12 and a 121-109 win in Portland on Feb. 13. The Wolves join the Knicks as the only other team in the NBA season to have swept three consecutive back-to-back sets and it marks just the fourth time in franchise history the Timberwolves have done so. On Feb. 27 and Feb. 28 Minnesota beat San Antonio and Memphis in back-to-back games, their fourth back-to-back set sweep of the season. To this point, The Timberwolves are 6-2 (.750) this season when playing on the second day of a back-to-back, which is second best in the NBA (Boston, 8-2). For an entire season, Minnesota's best record on no rest is 13-7 (.650) in 2003-04.

Minnesota finished their season going 18-8 in back-to-back games, 10-3 on the first night and 8-5 in the second night. The Wolves won 10+ games on the front end of the back-to-backs for the first time since 2013-14 and just the eighth time doing so in team history. The .769 winning percentage this season on the front end of back-to-backs is the best in team history.

THESE WOLVES BOUNCE BACK

Following the Timberwolves 116-107 loss on the road against the Nuggets on April 10 and the Wolves 109-106 victory over the Hawks on April 12, Minnesota is an NBA-best 21-4 (.840) in games immediately following a loss this season, the best mark in franchise history, besting the 2003-04 team. (19-5, .792).

The Wolves never lost three consecutive games the entire 2023-24 campaign. This marks just the second time in franchise history Minnesota avoided a three-game slide throughout an entire season (2003-04).

SHUTTING THE DOOR IN THE SECOND HALF

The Timberwolves were stingy on the defensive end this season, only allowing teams to average **51.5** points per game in the second half, while allowing opponents just **.437** shooting percentage from the floor, both were **tops in the NBA**.

Chris Finch was named Head Coach of the Minnesota Timberwolves on February 22, 2021, becoming the team's 16th Head Coach. On April 11, 2022, the Timberwolves announced a multi-year contract extension for Finch along with his coaching staff.

His 160 total wins over the last four seasons rank second in team history and his .558 winning percentage passes Flip Saunders' franchise-best mark (.521). After the Timberwolves' 99-96 win over the Golden State Warriors on Mar. 26, Finch recorded his 100th career win, joining Saunders as the only two coaches in Wolves history with 100 or more victories.

On Dec. 4, 2024, the NBA named Finch Western Conference Coach of the Month for October and November after guiding the Wolves to a 14-4 record to begin the 2023-24 season. It was the first monthly honor of his coaching career, he became the third Timberwolves head coach to win the award, joining Kevin McHale (January 2009) and Flip Saunders (April 2004, February 2003, January 2001 and January 2000). Following the Wolves' Feb. 4 win vs. Houston, Finch was selected to represent the Western Conference at the 2024 NBA All-Star Game in Indianapolis, given to the team with the best record through Feb. 4 (including tiebreaker scenarios).

This marked the first time in Finch's career being named an All-Star Head Coach and the second time in Timberwolves history a head coach has been named to the All-Star Game. Flip Saunders coached the Western Conference All-Stars to a 136-132 victory at the 2004 NBA All-Star Game in Los Angeles.

The Timberwolves finished the 2023-24 campaign 56-26, the second-highest win total in franchise history. Minnesota secured the No. 3 seed in the Western Conference, marking the third consecutive year making the NBA Playoffs, the most consecutive seasons making the playoffs since eight straight appearances from 1997-2004.

During the 2022-23 season, Finch led the Timberwolves to a 42-40 record, eclipsing 40 wins on the season in back-to-back seasons (46 in 2021-22) for the first time since the 2003-04 and 2004-05 seasons. After defeating the Oklahoma City Thunder on Apr. 14 in the final NBA Play-In Tournament game, the Wolves clinched a spot in the NBA Playoffs for the second consecutive season. This marked the first time clinching back-to-back playoff appearances since a string of eight straight from 1997-2004. The team's second place finish in the Northwest Division was the highest since winning the division in 2003-04. With the team's 151-131 win over the San Antonio Spurs on Apr. 8, the Timberwolves clinched a .500 or better record this for the third time since 2004-05. The team has now done so in back-to-back seasons (.561 in 2021-22) for the first time since the 2003-04 and 2004-05 seasons. After the team's 29 wins against Western Conference foes this season and 32 such wins last season, Minnesota has won 25+ games against the West in back-to-back years for the first time since 2003-04 and 2004-05. The 11 wins in January of 2023 were the most by a Wolves team in the month of January since winning 12 games in January of 2004.

During the 2021-22 season, Finch led the Timberwolves to a 46-36 record, the seventh-best record in club history, including a trip to the Playoffs for just the second time in the last 18 years. He helped guide the Wolves to a 26-15 record at Target Center and a 32-20 record against the Western Conference, the second time since 2004-05 with 30+ wins against the West. With the 136-130 victory over the Denver Nuggets on April 1, the Wolves finished the season 12-4 against Northwest Division foes, the most division wins by the team since the division was formed in 2004 and just the third time since 2004 winning 10+ division games. Additionally, Minnesota finished the season winning 10 straight games against Northwest division opponents, the most since 2004. The team finished the 2021-22 campaign with 20 road wins for the first time since the 2004-05 season and just the fifth time winning 20+ road games.

Finch took the helm mid-season in the 2020-2021 season, leading the Timberwolves to win half of their last 22 games, finishing 16-25 overall. After the All-Star break, Finch was able to unlock another level of talent in young players such as 2020-21 NBA All-Rookie First Team honoree Anthony Edwards, as well as Jaden McDaniels. Under Finch's guidance, Edwards was named the Western Conference Rookie of the Month three times last season (March, April and May), becoming the third player in Wolves history to earn the honor multiple times (Karl-Anthony Towns in 2015-16 and Andrew Wiggins in 2014-15).

Since arriving in Minnesota, Finch has jumped into helping the Twin Cities community. He currently serves on the Board of Directors of Second Harvest Heartland where he assists the organization, playing a critical role in helping Second Harvest Heartland fulfill its mission of ending hunger.

Finch, 54, has over 25 years of NBA and G League experience, serving most recently as an assistant coach under Nick Nurse and the Toronto Raptors this season. Prior to that, he made coaching stops with the New Orleans Pelicans as associate head coach from 2017-20, the Denver Nuggets as an assistant coach from 2016-17 and the Houston Rockets as an assistant coach from 2011-16. Finch was named the head coach of the Rio Grande Valley Vipers, the Rocket's G League affiliate in 2009. He led the Vipers to back-to-back G League Finals appearances, compiling a 67-33 (.670) record in his two seasons.

After leading Rio Grande Valley to the 2010 G League Championship, Finch received the Dennis Johnson Trophy as the league's best head coach.

The Reading, Pennsylvania native played overseas in the British Basketball League (BBL) for the Sheffield Sharks from 1993-97 before coaching the same team from 1997-2003. Finch was named the BBL Coach of the Year in 1998-99. He continued to coach overseas for 12 years including in Germany and Belgium.

Finch also served as the head coach of Great Britain's National Team from 2006-13, where he led the national team in the 2012 Summer Olympics in London. He also led them to a European Championship berth in 2009 and 2011, the team's first appearances since 1981.

A Franklin & Marshall College graduate in 1992, Finch was as a two-time All-American, and was inducted into the F&M Sports Hall of Fame in 2002. He started the final 115 games of his collegiate career and compiled a 102-13 record (.887), which stood as the most career wins as a starter in NCAA Division III history.

- Making his first start of this year's postseason (fifth career) in Game 5 at Denver, Nickeil Alexander-Walker finished with 14 points, including 4-of-5 from three and five assists. Game 5 marked his third career playoff game with 10+ points and 5+ rebounds, all of which have come during this postseason.
- In knocking down four shots from deep in Game 5, Alexander-Walker became the second Timberwolf (Edwards) and just the 13th player in NBA Playoff history to make 2+ threes in his first five playoff starts.
- Alexander-Walker finished the first half of Game 5 going 3-of-3 from deep and rejecting two shots. He became the first player in franchise history to record 3+ threes without a miss and 2+ blocks in a single half of a playoff game.

- In 28:45 minutes of action off the bench in Game 1 vs. Phoenix on April 20, Alexander-Walker finished with a Playoff career-high 18 points on 7-of-12 shooting, including 4-of-9 from deep and a game-high four steals. His four steals set a tied a franchise record for most steals in a Game 1 (Terrell Brandon: May 9, 1999, at San Antonio) and set a franchise record for most steals off the bench in a playoff game.
- Alexander-Walker became the first player in franchise history to come off the bench in a playoff game and score 15+ points while recording 4+ steals and just the 44th player in NBA Playoff history to do so (since 1973-74 season).

Anderson scored all 11 of his points in the first half, tied for his most points in the first half of a game (regular or postseason) in a Timberwolves jersey (5X; MR: March 31, 2023, vs. Los Angeles) and tied for the most points in any half of a playoff game in his career (May 23, 2021, at Utah; first half).
- Anderson stuffed the stat sheet on April 2 vs. Houston, finishing with 13 points on 6-of-8 shooting, including 1-of-2 from deep, six rebounds, nine assists, two steals and two blocks in 30:09 minutes off the bench. It marked his first game of the season with 10+ points/5+ rebounds/5+ assists/2+ steals/2+ blocks, his fifth such game of his career and the first time doing so as a reserve.
- Anderson became the first player in the NBA this season to come off the bench and record 10+ points/5+ rebounds/5+ assists/2+ steals/2+ blocks while shooting 75.0%+ from the field and just the 12th player in NBA history to do so. Anderson is the first player in franchise history to record such a stat line.
- In 22:32 minutes of action off the bench against the Pistons on March 27, Anderson recorded 14 points on 5-of-8 shooting, five assists and two steals. The game marked his 15th 10+ point game of the season (180th career), seven of which have come in the month of March. It also marked his third consecutive and ninth 10+ point/5+ assist game of the season (61st career). It is just the fourth time in his career he has strung together 3+ games with 10+ points and 5+ assists.

- Rudy Gobert added 13 points on 4-of-5 shooting, a team-high-tying 10 rebounds and a block in Game 4 in Dallas, marking his fourth double-double with at least one block in this year's postseason and his 28th such game of his career. Since joining the league in the 2013 NBA Draft, only six players have recorded more such playoff games. Gobert also joins Towns and Garnett as the only players in franchise history to record 4+ such games in a single postseason.
- Gobert ended Game 2 vs. Dallas with 16 points on 6-of-10 shooting, 10 rebounds, two steals and a block, notching his 13th career playoff game with 15+ points/10+ rebounds/1+ block, all of which have come on 60.0% shooting or better. Since entering the league in the 2013 NBA Draft, only Anthony Davis (16 games) has recorded more such playoff games. His 13 such games moved him into a three-way tie with Moses Malone and Shawn Kemp for the 11th most such games in NBA Playoff history.
- Gobert finished Game 5 in Denver with 18 points on a perfect 7-of-7 shooting, a game-high 11 rebounds, two steals and two blocks, marking his fourth double-double of this postseason and his 38th career postseason double-double. Game 5 marked his 507th career game (regular and postseason) with 2+ blocks, the third most such games among all active players. Gobert also became just the second player in franchise playoff history to record 2+ blocks and 1+ steal in three straight road games (Garnett; 3X MR: April 27 – May 12, 2004).
- Game 5 marked Gobert's second career playoff game with a point/rebound double-double while going perfect from the field (min. five FGA). He joins DeAndre Jordan as the only player in NBA history to record multiple such games. No player has done so more than twice.
- Gobert finished Game 4 vs. Denver with 11 points on 3-of-5 shooting and a game-high 14 rebounds, notching his third double-double of this postseason and the 38th such game of his career. Gobert's 38 career playoff double-doubles are the seventh-most double-doubles in NBA Playoff history since he joined the league in 2013-14.

- Jaden McDaniels ended Game 3 at Dallas with 15 points on 6-of-8 shooting, including 3-of-4 from deep, marking his sixth game of this postseason with 15+ points on 50.0% shooting or better. McDaniels became the fifth player in franchise history to record 6+ such games in a single postseason.
- McDaniels led the way for the Timberwolves in Game 1 vs. Dallas, with a team-high 24 points on 9-of-15 shooting, including a playoff career-high 6-of-9 from deep, four rebounds and three assists. Recent Notables (Playoffs):

- Karl-Anthony Towns ended Game 4 in Dallas with 25 points on 9-of-13 shooting, including 4-of-5 from three and five rebounds, marking his third 25+ point performance of this postseason and his eighth such game of his career. Towns is the first player in franchise postseason history to record 25+ points and 5+ rebounds while shooting 80.0%+ from deep (min. five 3FGA).
- Towns scored 20 of his 25 points in Game 4 in the second half, marking his fourth playoff career 20+ point half. Only Edwards (nine halves) has recorded more such halves in franchise history.
- Towns ended Game 1 vs. Dallas with 16 points and seven rebounds, marking his 18th career playoff game with 15+ points and 5+ rebounds and his 7th such game of this postseason. Towns' 18 career playoff games with 15+ points and 5+ rebounds rank second in franchise history (Garnett: 44).
- Towns led the way in Game 7 with a team-high-tying 23 points on 8-of-14 shooting, a team-high 12 rebounds and two steals, notching his second-consecutive double-double, his sixth double-double of this year's playoffs and his 18th such playoff game of his career. Game 7 also marked his 12-career 20+ point playoff game, nine of which have been on the road, including all five of his 20+ point games in this year's playoffs.
- Game 7 also marked Towns' fifth straight road playoff game with 20+ points. That's the second-longest such streak in team postseason history (Edwards — six consecutive games: April 19, 2023 — May 6, 2024).
- Towns ended Game 6 with 10 points, a game-high 13 rebounds and a team-high-tying and postseason career-high five assists. Game 6 marked his first career playoff game with 10+ points/10+ rebounds/5+ assists. Towns joins Kevin Garnett (23 games) as the only players in franchise playoff history to record 10+ points/10+ rebounds/5+ assists in a game.
