IPSSA member alert

Unfair and outrageous contract terms

Recently, some IPSSA members were asked to sign an "Addendum to Pool Service Contract." The Addendum (1) requires the pool service contractor to acknowledge that they have read and understand laws relating to pool and spa safety and health; (2) includes an agreement to abide in the law; (3) requires the pool service contractor to provide written notice of any potential violations of the laws or regulations that the contractor discovers, as well as recommended steps to resolve the potential violations; and (4) includes an agreement by the pool service contractor to pay the management company and persons associated with it, for all damages that may arise from the failure of the management company or property owner to comply with any local, state or federal law, except fair housing and ADA claims.

A reasonable person could argue about whether the first three provisions of the Addendum are fair and reasonable, but the fourth clause appears to make the pool contractor liable for anything that happens at the premises, not just the pool. In other words, the pool service contractor would take on responsibilities

similar to that of an insurance company, covering the property owner and manager from nearly all risks, and without having assessed the risks or having collected premium for taking on those risks.

For example, if a tenant or visitor trips and falls in the parking lot of the premises, the pool service contractor could be forced to pay the damages. If a tenant or guest tampers with an unlocked electrical panel and is injured, the pool service contractor could be forced to pay the damages (repair the electrical panel and damages to the injured party). If the pool service contractor notices a pool or spa hazard and immediately notifies the manager/owner, and the manager/owner does nothing, and someone is hurt or property is damaged, the pool service contractor could be forced to pay the damages. Is this fair and reasonable? Of course not.

IPSSA is NOT recommending that its members, or anyone, refuse to sign the proposed Addendum. Doing so could be unlawful under antitrust laws. Rather, IPSSA is recommending that pool service contractors carefully review all contracts prior to signing them to make sure they are appropriate for that contractor. Most contracts are different from one another;





Answers to recent questions asked to IPSSA's insurance broker

This month's question comes from a member in San Fernando Valley.

Question:

I accidentally overfilled a pool yesterday. There wasn't any damage as the water ran into the street, but a neighbor reported the incident to the Department of Water and Power. I'm told that the home owner or I will be fined. Am I covered for the fine, if I receive one?

Answer:

Fines are never covered by general liability insurance. That includes fines issued by a municipality, county, state or federal agency. There is a strong public policy against permitting insurance for fines as they are meant to dissuade people from doing wrongful acts. Imagine, for example, if a person could buy insurance to pay penalties for not paying federal or state income tax.

From an insurance analysis, a fine doesn't meet the definition of

an occurrence under a general liability policy. Filling the water wasn't accidental and there is no damage to tangible property, such as a hillside or home furnishings. Unfortunately, this is the kind of situation you will need to handle

The fight continues

It was another busy month for the California Pool & Spa Association (CPSA) and Association of Pool & Spa Professionals (APSP), as members and representatives of both organizations responded to existing local pool filling and proposed pool building restrictions. Once again the pool industry and consumers prevailed after the materials produced and provided by CPSA and the testimony of


CPSA/APSP industry representative Jose Solorio convinced the City of Del Mar's Design Review Board to not proceed with recommending a moratorium on pool construction. Additionally the City of Signal Hill re-visited their Water Conservation Program which includes a pool filling prohibition, and Council Members agreed to consider changes relative to swimming pools when they adopt an updated Urban Management Water Plan sometime next year. This underscores the importance of CPSA's ongoing efforts to remove the restrictions on pools and spas in the state template for emergency shortage plans that has plagued the industry since it was adopted some 7 years ago.





Responding to CPSA alerts regarding the Del Mar Design Review Board consideration of a new swimming pool construction ban, association members participated in full force with Solorio at the Wednesday meeting. In what was an hour-long discussion on the issue, Jeff Mitchell (Dynasty Pools), Bruce Dunn (Mission Pools) and Scott McKenna (Gardner Pool Plasters) joined Solorio

in providing testimony and responding to over 15 questions. CPSA President John Norwood, who formerly represented the City of Del Mar on issues before the state Legislature, also utilized his relationships to speak with the City Manager to discuss the moratorium, who was very complimentary of the association's materials and timely response. These collective efforts proved successful as

the Design Review Board abandoned the pool construction moratorium because the facts demonstrate the restriction is inherently discriminatory and inconsistent with water conservation goals. Instead, the board will form a subcommittee to examine more effective requirements like those promulgated by CPSA which include mandatory pool covers.

Solorio also participated at a City Council meeting in Signal Hill on behalf of CPSA and APSP after the CPSA contracted-monitoring service discovered a pool filling moratorium contained in the city's Water Shortage Contingency Plan. Speaking to industry opposition, Solorio provided alternative restrictions that would not adversely impact the industry and listed the cities that recently repealed the exact restriction contained in their municipal code. Council Members were more reluctant to immediately change this provision, but agreed to consider our recommendations as they would be reforming their plan next year. The City Council was impressed by CPSA's proactive involvement with the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California, which serves 17 water districts and hundreds of Southern California cities, regarding updates to their model ordinance to remove the pool filling restriction. Most importantly, the CPSA has provided comments to the Department of Water Resources (DWR)

who is updating Urban Water Management Plans. This is a substantial undertaking, but if successful would eliminate local filling restrictions.

The industry enjoyed successes this week, but there is still a heavy workload remaining. Every week both associations receive 5-10 alerts regarding water conservation programs, which typically include a few cities with existing or proposed pool filling restrictions. In addition to organizing local response efforts now in conjunction with APSP, CPSA is invested with DWR in revising Urban Water Management Plans. State proceedings require patience as they are designed to allow for discourse and input from stakeholders, but this long-term approach could be the key to remedying local pool filling restrictions that have been proven to be ineffective and contrary to water conservation.



National Swimming Pool Foundation® celebrates its 50th Anniversary

Non-profit aims for a century of keeping pools safer and open

The National Swimming Pool Foundation® celebrates its 50th year in 2015 and sets goals to further keep aquatics safer and create more swimmers. The Foundation will commemorate the event at the World Aquatic HealthTM Conference on October 7, 2015 in Arizona at the Desert Foothills.

Back in the 1960s, there was an explosion of interest in swimming pools thanks to the prosperity created after World War II and advances in plastic materials and disinfection. As the pool and spa industry grew, a group of visionary leaders, the National Spa & Pool Institute, realized a need for an educational organization to research and supplement practical aquatic knowledge for the industry. In 1965, that organization became the National Swimming Pool Foundation (NSPF®), a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit, with the original mission to receive and maintain funds to use for scientific and educational purposes which would influence the design, construction, and operation of swimming pools and spas.


The seventies were a good year for the pool industry and the NSPF. As pools were becoming larger and more unique, the NSPF developed a mail-in correspondence course, which after successful completion, one received the Certified Pool/Spa Operator® (CPO®) Certification. The CPO Certification is to this day, the NSPF's most popular creation as it has resulted in more than 400,000 successful CPO certifications in nearly 100 countries! This program is designed to provide individuals with the basic knowledge, techniques, and skills needed to operate pools and spas.

When the nineties arrived, consumer's wanted lower maintenance pools with higher quality automatic cleaners, control systems, and safety devices such as pool alarms and safety covers. A higher standard was also implemented in the NSPF, as then-CEO Mr. Les Kowalsky required pool operators to train and recertify every five years to have a valid CPO Certification. With this raised standard, the Certified Pool/Spa Operator Certification gained both popularity and credibility throughout the United States.

Many changes occurred when the new millennial began, the National Swimming Pool Foundation moved from Texas (distribution) and New York (headquarters) to Colorado Springs in 2002. A year later, Thomas Lachocki, Ph.D., was



But, what happens if you haven't declared a beneficiary? You will lose control of who receives your benefits. The payment of funds will be delayed and, if the benefits are part of a probate, it could take a year or more for your loved ones to get those funds.

The good news is that, when your Beneficiary Designation Form is on file at the IPSSA financial office, the check for your life insurance benefit is issued as soon as the death certificate is received by the insurance company.

Call the financial office (888-391-6012) if you are not sure whether or not your Beneficiary Designation Form has been filed. If not, or if you want to change your beneficiary, you can download the form from the "Members Only" page of www.ipssa.com.



appointed the new CEO with experience in areas of chemistry, research, education, and business development. With Lachocki's appointment, the NSPF reinvented itself with the goal of creating more value for the non-profit's customers.

Not a year later, and the NSPF released the new, full-color, inby the NSPF as an unrivaled educa-

dexed, and updated Pool/Spa OperatorTM Handbook. The board hired longtime NSPF instructor, Ronald Ford, to update the handbook, which resulted in a 30 percent increase in those achieving their CPO certification by the next year. In 2004 the annual World Aquatic Health™ Conference was launched

aquatics field. That same year, Alex Antoniou

was hired on as the Foundation's first Director of Educational Programs. At the time, there was only one course, the two-day CPO certification program; once Antoniou came on, the NSPF's portfolio grew quickly and many "firsts" were launched. The nonprofit was the first in the industry to present a comprehensive series of online training programs that focused on specialized programs in aquatics, like the Certified Pool/Spa Inspector, Aquatic Play Feature, and 60 other courses. The NSPF was also first to fund creation of a science-based, free Model Aquatic Health Code, which is now published by the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention (CDC).

By 2006 the NSPF's international efforts expanded with the release of a Spanish Pool & Spa Operator® handbook. A year later a French version was printed and ready for the masses. During this time of tremendous innovation,

the NSPF reinvested about \$4 million in research grants. The research focused on helping keep pools safer from drowning, illness, injury and chemical exposure. Additionally, it focused on the documentation of how immersion and water activity can benefit an individual's health, thus creating more swimmers which helps keep pools open. In 2007 the Pool Operator PrimerTM online course and Pool Operator FusionTM classroom course was introduced as a blended learning course that resulted in a CPO Certification after both the portions are successfully completed. Two years later, the NSPF partnered with the American Red Cross and created the Home PoolEssentialsTM, an online course that teaches backyard pool safety and maintenance for home owners.

Initiatives were then taken in 2009 as the NSPF's new mission became "To encourage healthier living by increasing aquatic activity through education and research." To complement this new

mission, the NSPF initiated the 10 year Step Into SwimTM campaign to create one million more swimmers. The goal being to reduce drowning, improve health, and build demand for our field.

Today, the pool and spa industry continues to grow while the National Swimming Pool Foundation remains committed to furthering advances in research to demonstrate how aquatic activity creates healthier lives. The continued growth and development of the organization means constant evolution for the industry. Recently, the NSPF became a sponsor of Swim Today, a campaign that is meant to give a new splash of initiative to the sport of swimming for youths. Since 2003, the organization has grown from three employees to 19 to better keep up with the flourishing needs of the industry. The NSPF looks forward to support initiatives that help to keep pools safer and keep pools open, to assure that the future of aquatics is more accessible to the people who enjoy the benefits of getting into the water.

"The innovations we have created has resulted in 12 consecutive years of mission-focused trainingprogram growth. As a result, we are able to give back to prevent bad things and to promote good things," stated CEO Tom Lachocki. "All we ask is that everyone in our field train their staff. If you chose to use NSPF materials, thank you! We take your confidence very seriously and commit to serve you for decades to come. What's more, we intend to give back to help mankind through aquatics."







Matching funds available from IPSSA Inc.

IPSSA Inc. has a matching grant fund of \$24,000 to assist individual regions and chapters for community involvement, safety programs, and promoting IPSSA to the public. The spirit of the matching grant is to foster IPSSA promotions by facilitating new ideas from individual members, chapters and regions.

The matching grant funds shall be allocated evenly by region in each given year. In the event that a region does not request funds in a given year, that region's representative may elect to reallocate their portion to the matching grant fund for redistribution. Any redistribution of funds must be approved by the BORD.

The BORD will match, dollar for dollar, up to the budget amount once a matching grant is approved by the regional Board.

Each region shall determine how to use its allotment of funds without BORD approval once it has been approved by the regional Board.

Individual members, chapters and regions of IPSSA in good standing qualify for matching grants.

- Matching grant requests must be submitted in writing to the regional director by December 1st each year.
- The regional director shall qualify the request to meet the spirit of the matching grant program.
- The region must approve the grant by either a regional Board meeting, regional Board teleconference, or e-mail ballot, and the results will be posted in the regional minutes.
- The regional director shall then request the funds from the IPSSA BORD president or chief financial officer without BORD approval, as long as the requested amount does not exceed the region's budgeted amount.

there is no legal requirement of uniformity or fairness. Contract terms may be very reasonable, highly unreasonable, or a mixture of both. And, the form you signed a week ago might have substantially different terms than the contract you are asked to sign today. This is why it is important to read every pool and spa service contract or addendum that you sign before signing it.

Concerning the Addendum described above, Clause 3 appears to add to the duties of the pool serv ice contractor, at no additional fee. Further, in the event of an incident/claim, the property owner/ manager will argue that the pool service contractor breached the contract by not giving written notice of a potential violation of state or federal law or regulation, and is therefore responsible for the loss. Thus, this clause significantly increases the duty owned by the pool service contractor. Again. each pool service contractor should examine these terms and decide whether or not it is willing to accept the risks and benefits associated with them.

Also concerning the Addendum above, Clauses 1 and 2 are

not particularly unreasonable, and they create an inference that the remainder of the Addendum is just as reasonable when, in fact, it may not be. Clauses 1 and 2 apply to the pool service contractor whether those terms are included in the agreement or not. If you are a pool service professional, you are already obligated to know the laws and regulations, and to conform to those rules. Thus, the first two clauses were completely unnecessary, but may have been to give the appearance of reasonableness, or provide cover in which highly offensive contract terms might be "concealed in plain sight."

Some competitors may fail to read or care about the provisions of an Addendum it/they are asked

to sign, and simply sign it. This happens in every trade and profession. Signing agreements without reviewing them is careless and irresponsible, yet the owner or manager may refuse to do business with your firm if you refuse to agree to unreasonable terms, and it is lawful for them to do so. Those contractors (that don't review contracts, or that accept risky terms) are apparently willing to bet everything, including their business and potentially their home and other assets, that nothing will go wrong. Each business person should ask itself whether it is in their best interest to make that het.


There is a legal doctrine, called "unconscionability" under which the terms of a contract or so oner-

ous and unfair that a court may refuse to enforce that provision of the contract. I believe Clause 4 above is unconscionable. However, unconscionability is a defense that is argued in court. It is my belief that acceptance of unconscionable contract terms is a roadmap to the courthouse, and exceedingly expensive to address when something goes wrong.

If your company does not have a relationship with a business lawyer, it should. Depending on the level of knowledge and experience of your company, it may be acceptable to review many contracts yourself, and consult with a lawyer only when necessary. It is acceptable, perhaps even wise, to ask for an estimate of legal fees prior to the review, and to limit the scope of review to the areas of the agreement that you consider most important. If this is unacceptable to the lawyer, you may want to look for another lawyer. A good place to start is to ask your colleagues who they use for contract review, and knows something about the pool and spa business.

Remember, it is never acceptable to agree with colleagues NOT

to sign any addendum, or a particular addendum, or to punish vendors or competitors for entering into agreements, including unconscionable agreements. It is acceptable to discuss contract concerns with other IPSSA members, but only for the purpose of understanding the contract, and never for purposes of coordinating a response to it.


