

# **National Republican Presidential Poll Results**

### **POLLING METHODOLOGY**

- Likely Republican primary voters (using both registered and modeled Republican voters), conducted July 18-22, 2023 (3.0% MOE with 95% confidence interval)
- Sample size: 1,100 (68% texted cell phones, 32% live dialed landlines/cell phones "hybrid" poll)
- Gender: 51% female, 49% male
- Age Range: 9% 18-34 years old, 20% 35-54 years old, 25% 55-64 years old, 46% 65 years old and up
- <u>Geography (states/time zones)</u>: Eastern Time Zone outside of Southern/Border states: 25%, Eastern Time Zone within Southern/Border states: 19%, Central Time Zone outside of Southern/Border states: 12%, Central Time Zone within Southern/Border states: 24%, Mountain Time Zone: 9%, Pacific Time Zone: 11%, Alaska/Hawaii: <1% (*Listing of state groupings is graphically depicted in Exhibit A*).

### **SUMMARY**

JMC Analytics and Polling conducted this poll at its own expense. There are two main takeaways from this poll: (1) President Trump retains enough residual goodwill among Republican primary voters to be the dominant candidate in the Presidential race at the present time, and (2) specific issue positions held by Republicans are not as monolithically "across the line" conservative as stereotypically thought.

All of the major Republican candidates have at least 70% name recognition, while for former President Trump and Governor DeSantis, their name recognition is near unanimous. Furthermore, despite the heavy shelling DeSantis has sustained, he and former President Trump have strong favorability numbers (71-26% for Trump, 65-23% for DeSantis). The only other candidate even approaching this level of strong name recognition is Senator Tim Scott (51-13% favorability/unfavorability, with 86% name recognition).

The challenge Gov. DeSantis (and arguably any other Republican challenger) faces is this: Republican primary voters have fond memories of the Trump Presidency: 83% believe he did a great job as President, although 28% state that he did a great job AND that it's time for new leadership. That 55% residual percentage is consistently about the level of President Trump's strength in various ballot test configurations: when faced against "someone else", he has a 53-37% lead. Against DeSantis one on one, he leads 53-31%. And in a crowded Republican field, he leads with 53% (17% favor DeSantis, and 9% are undecided).

Republican primary voters do not monolithically consider themselves identifiably conservative on every issue. A 39% plurality wants a candidate conservative on economic issues who is pro-life, and another 1% favors a focus only on moral/social issues. However, 35% want an "America First" candidate, while another 19% favor a candidate conservative on economic issues who is pro-choice. The abortion issue similarly illustrates the complexity of opinion among Republicans and arguably explains their underperformance in the 2022 midterm elections. While 67% describe themselves as "pro-life", only 44 of that 67% describe themselves as pro-life without exceptions. Furthermore, another 27% identifies as pro-choice.

In summary, residual affection Republican primary voters have for former President Trump has enabled him to attain a dominant position in the crowded primary field at the present time.
