

## **National Republican Presidential Poll Results**

#### **POLLING METHODOLOGY**

- Likely Republican primary voters (using both registered and modeled Republican voters), conducted August 14-17, 2023 (3.0% MOE with 95% confidence interval)
- Sample size: 1,100 (71% texted cell phones, 29% live dialed landlines/cell phones "hybrid" poll)
- Gender: 50% male, 50% female
- Age Range: 10% 18-34 years old, 21% 35-54 years old, 23% 55-64 years old, 45% 65 years old and up
- <u>Geography (states/time zones)</u>: Eastern Time Zone outside of Southern/Border states: 24%, Eastern Time Zone within Southern/Border states: 19%, Central Time Zone outside of Southern/Border states: 13%, Central Time Zone within Southern/Border states: 24%, Mountain Time Zone: 8%, Pacific Time Zone: 11%, Alaska/Hawaii: <1% (*Listing of state groupings is graphically depicted in Exhibit A*).

#### **SUMMARY**

JMC Analytics and Polling conducted this poll at its own expense. There are three main takeaways from this poll: (1) former President Trump has maintained his dominance among the Republican field, (2) Ron DeSantis has seen some softening in his support, and (3) Trump's possible skipping of the debate wouldn't matter to most Republican primary voters.

Since the last poll, Ron DeSantis has seen some slippage in both his approvals and on his ballot test: in the previous poll, he had a 65-23% approval rating and 17% on the ballot test; now he's at 61-25% approval and 13% on the ballot test. And while former President Trump has seen minor slippage (not surprising given the multiple indictments), he remains above 50% support on the ballot test (64% among those who watch FOX/Newsmax/OAN), and no one is even close to challenging him, although it's worth noting that Vivek Ramaswamy has moved into third place.

Incidentally, the "red wall" which is fortifying Trump is not only rock solid Evangelical support (he has a 58-14% lead over DeSantis), but over 60% support from those with less than a college degree. In fact, Trump's 63-11% lead over DeSantis among those without a college degree is noticeably different than his 41-15% lead among those with at least a college degree.

In summary, former President Trump remains the dominant player in the Republican field, and no one has yet been able to establish himself/herself as a credible alternative as long as Trump is on the ballot.
