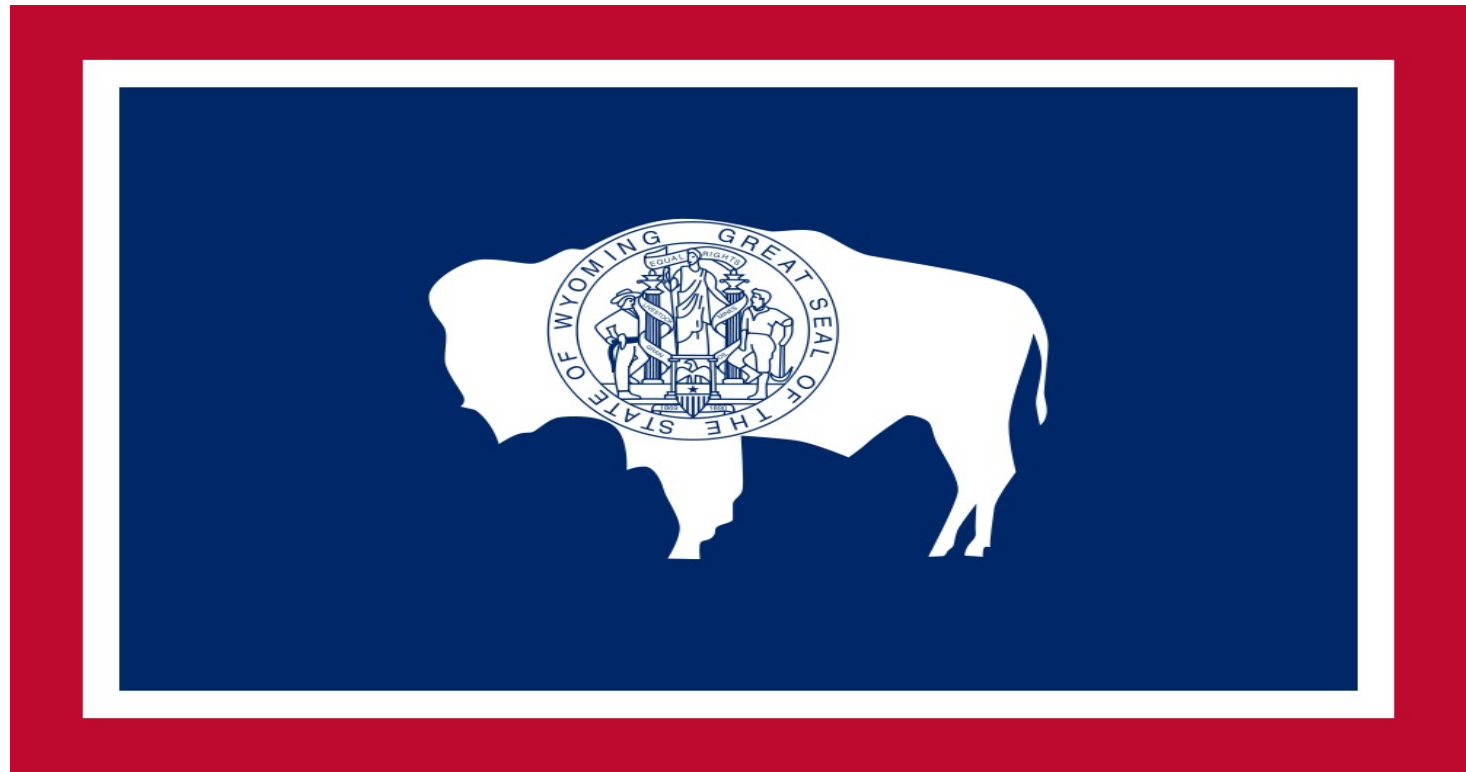

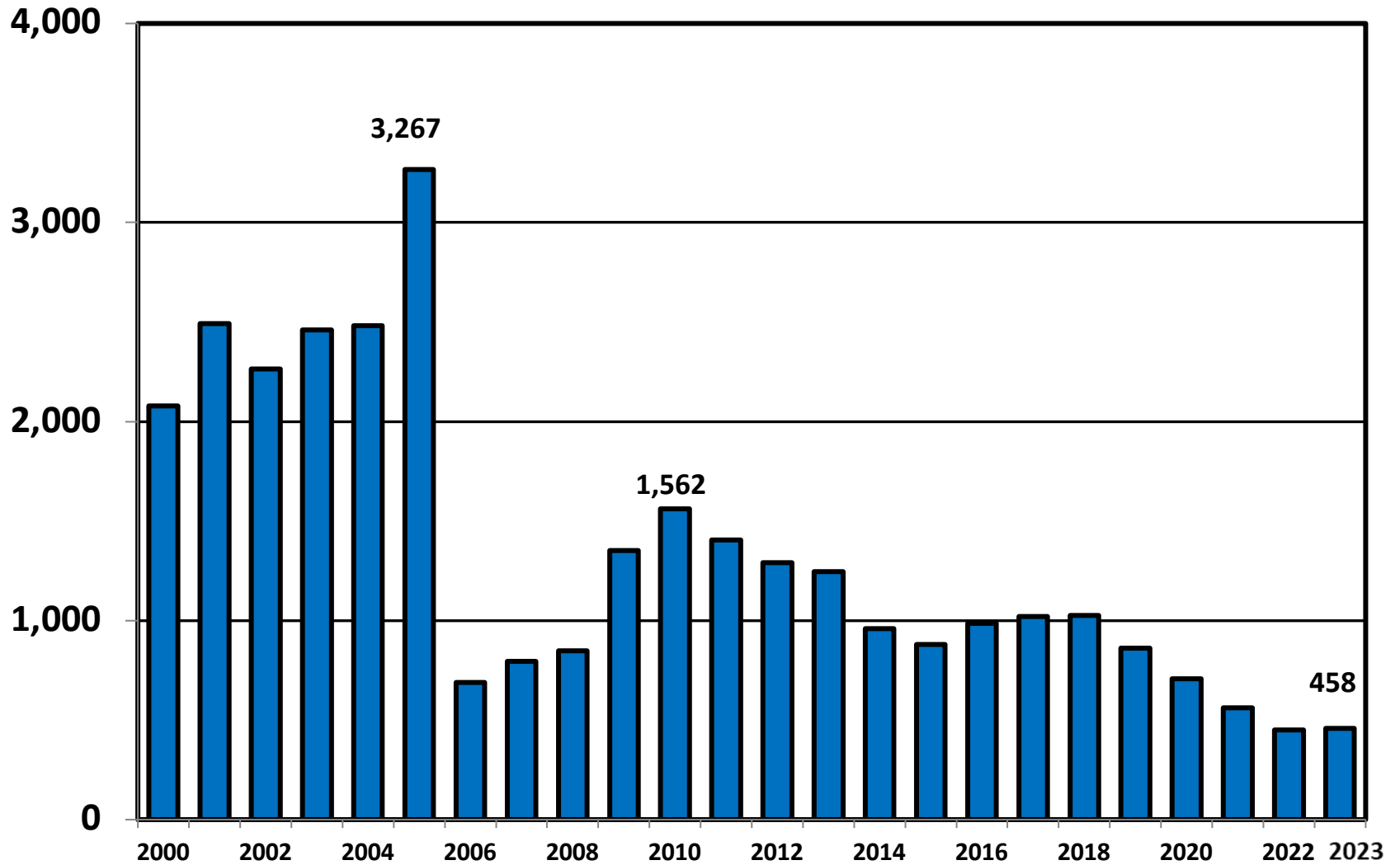

Total Filings Relative to Population 2000 - 2023



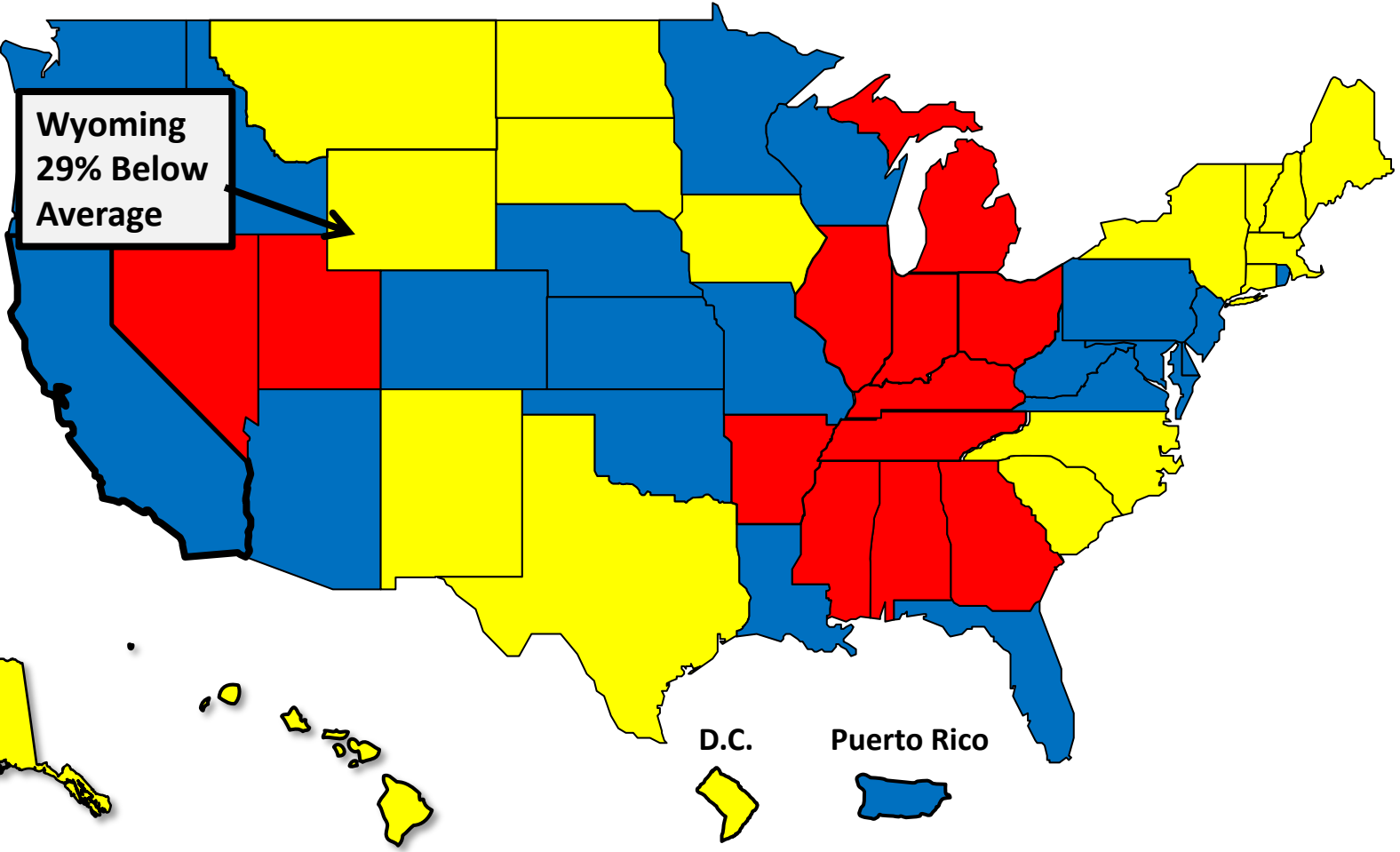

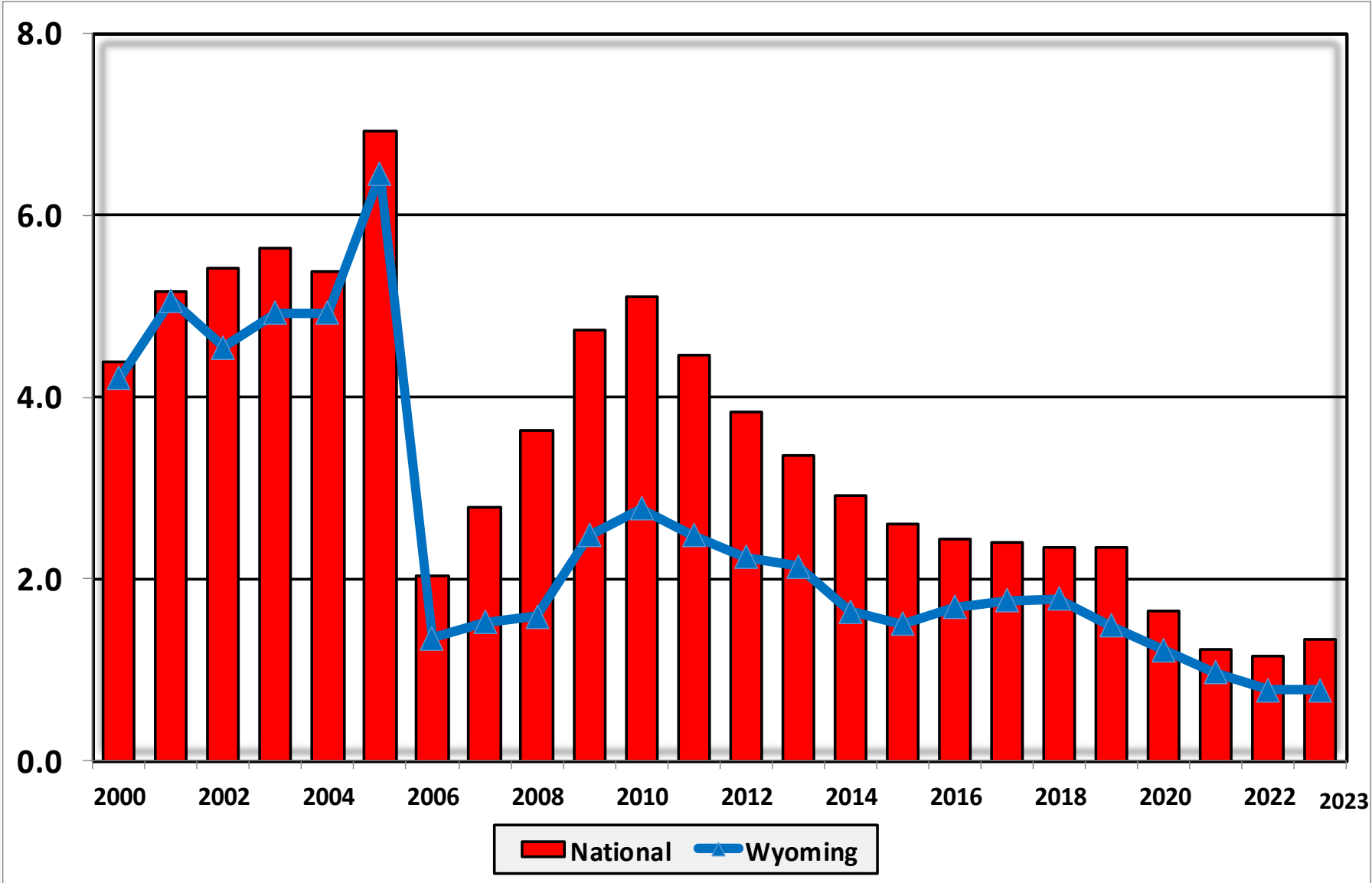
Within 25%

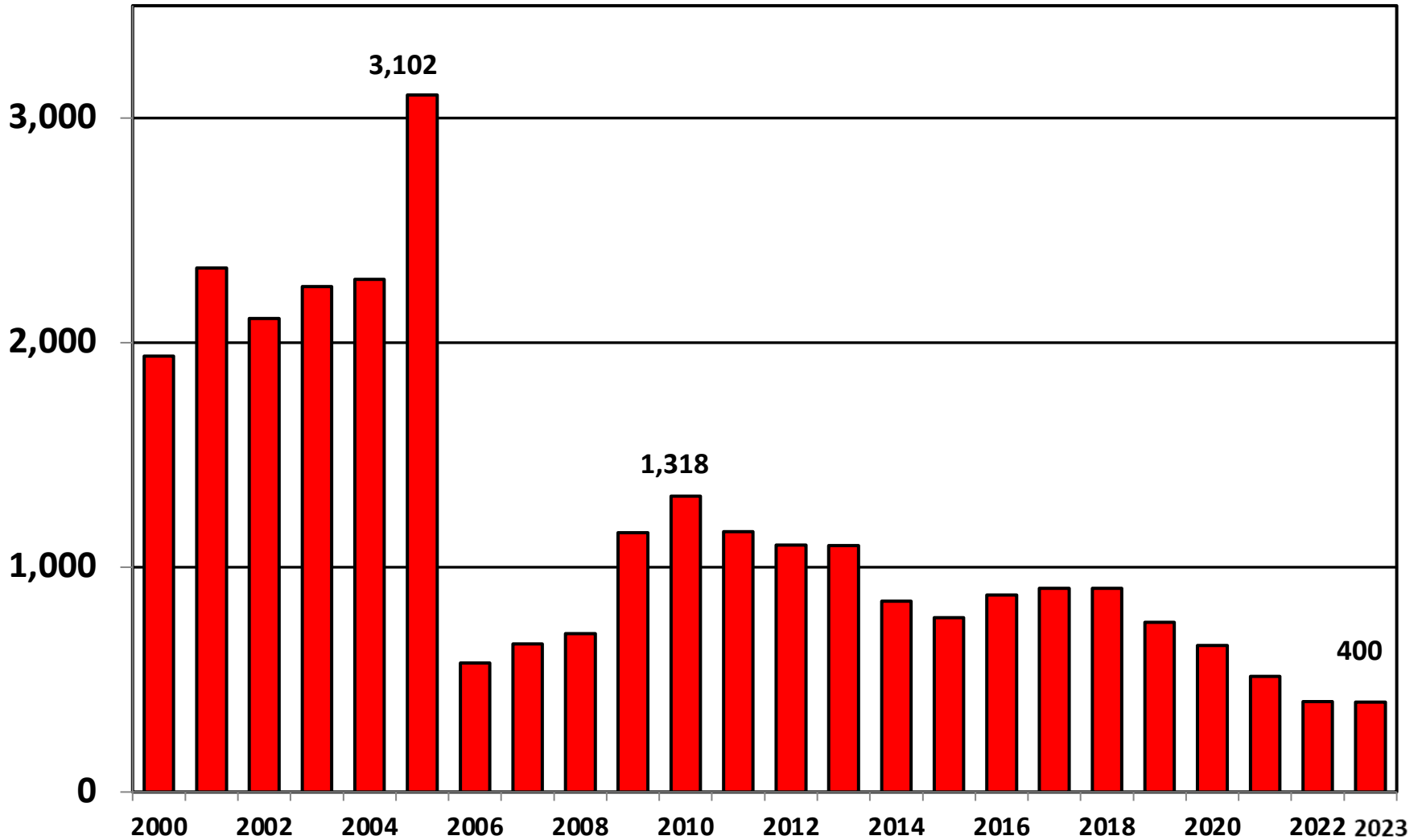

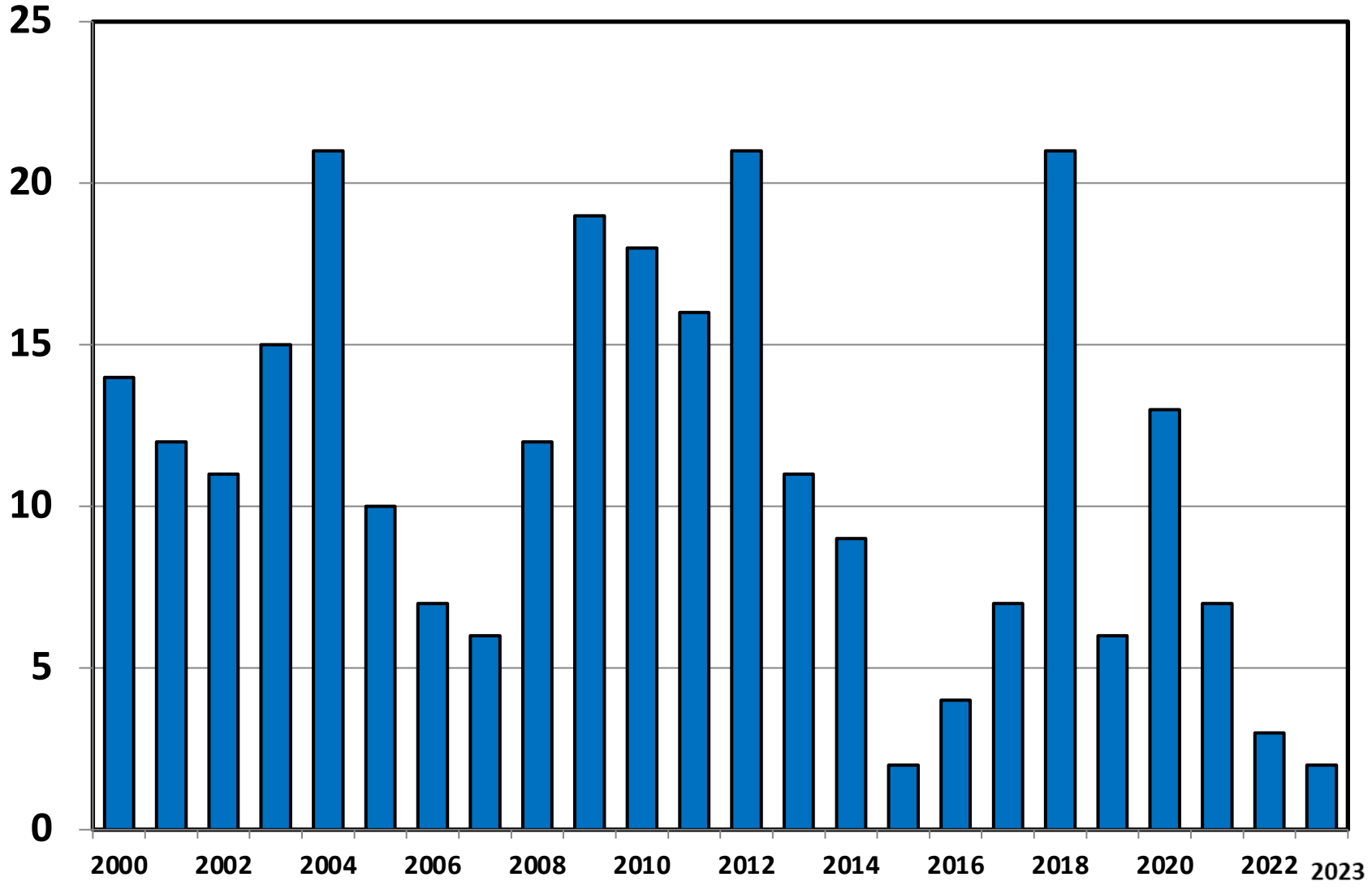
Bankruptcy Filings per 1,000 Population Wyoming vs. National Average 2000 - 2023



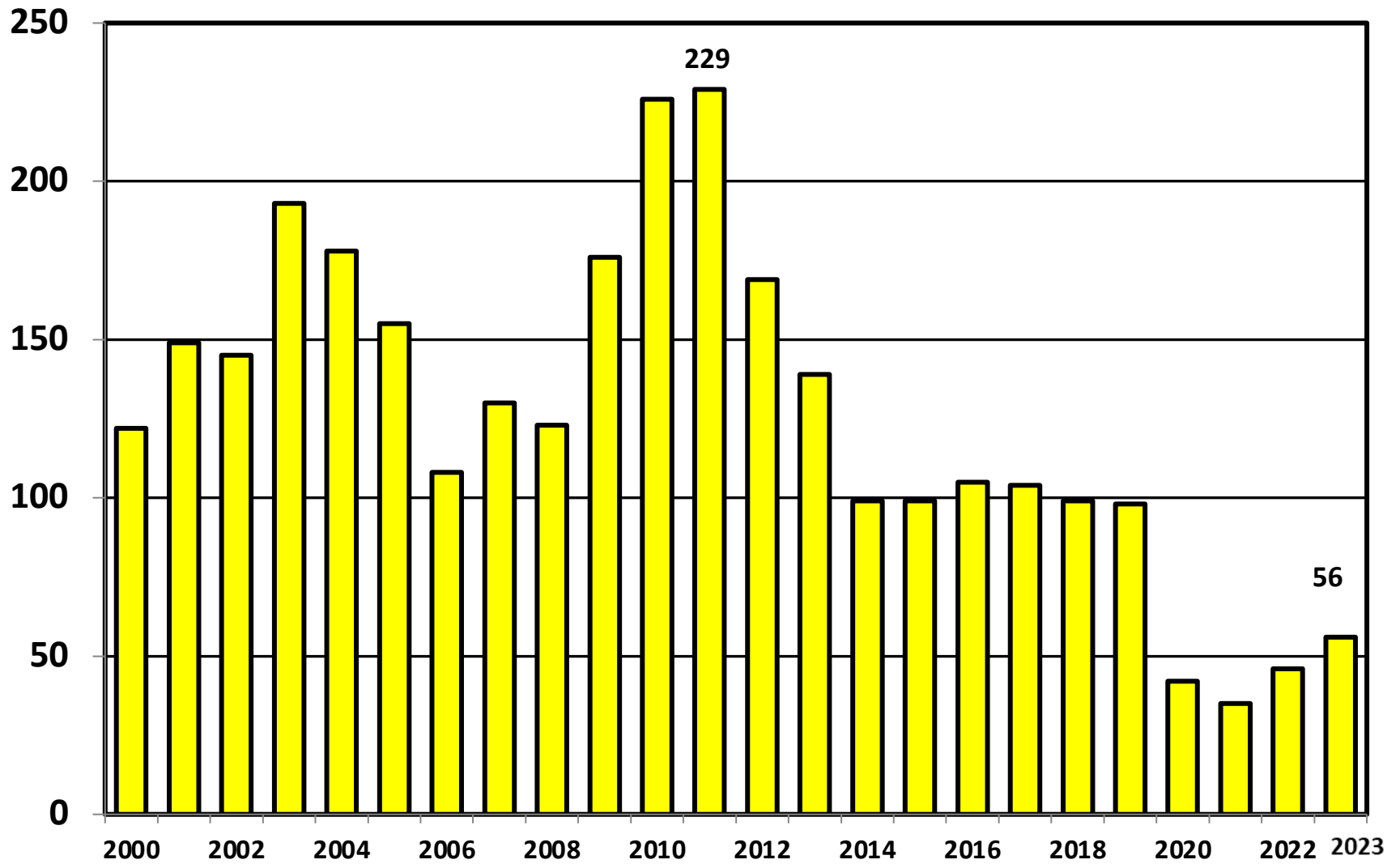
District of Wyoming Chapter 7 Cases Filed 2000 - 2023



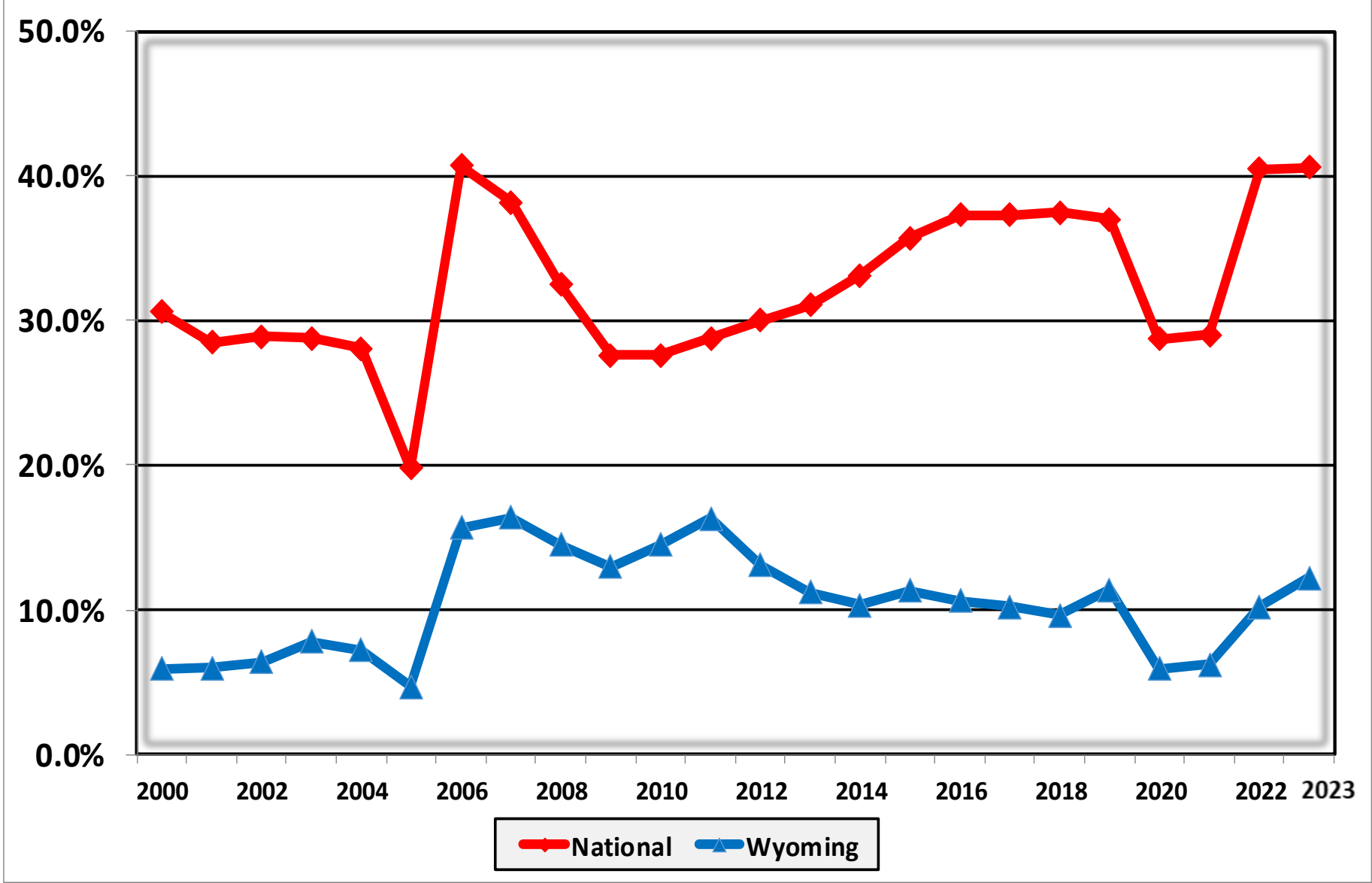
Chapter 11 Cases Filed in Wyoming 2000 - 2023



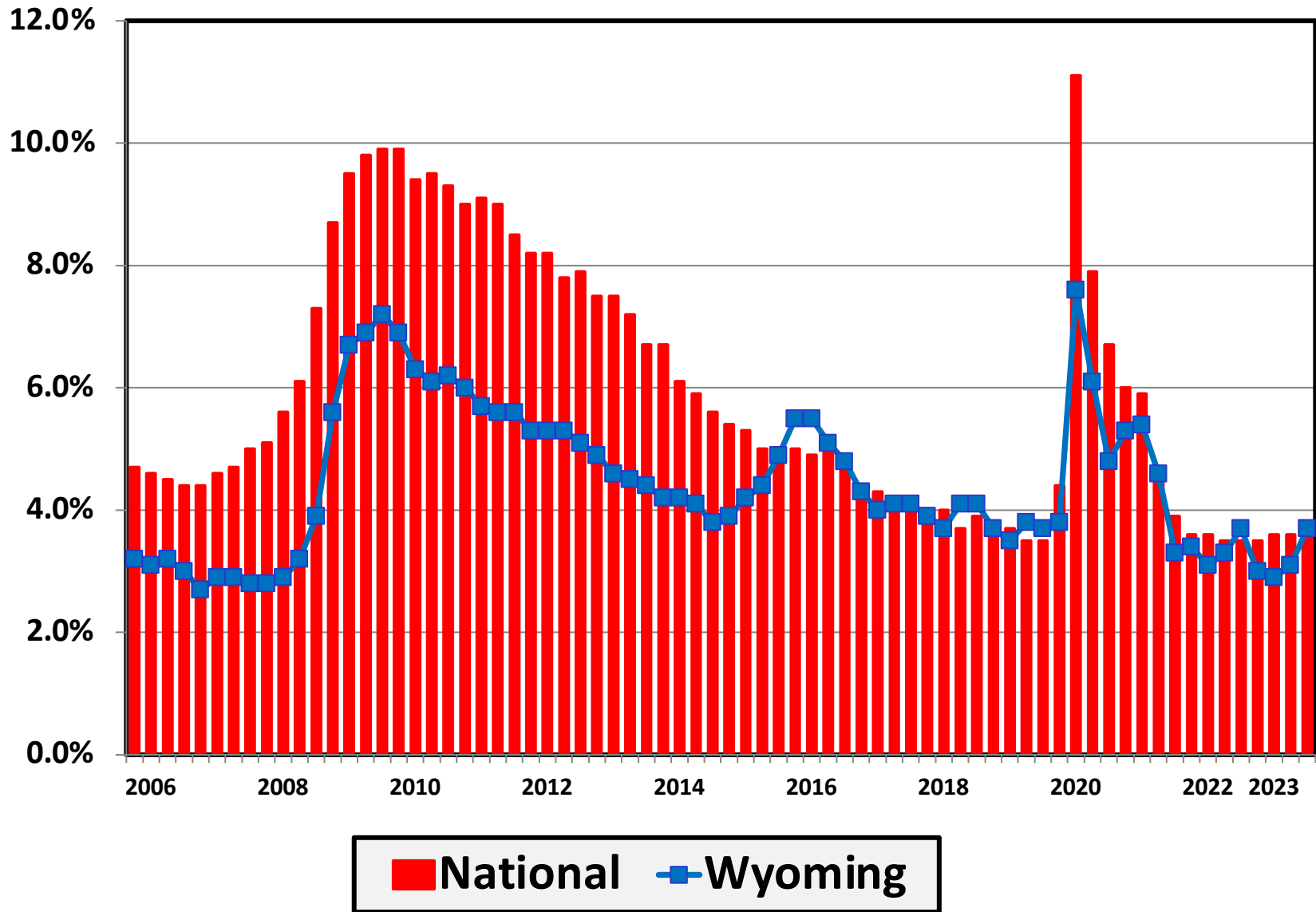
District of Wyoming Chapter 13 Cases Filed 2000 - 2023

Calendar Years 2000 - 2023**

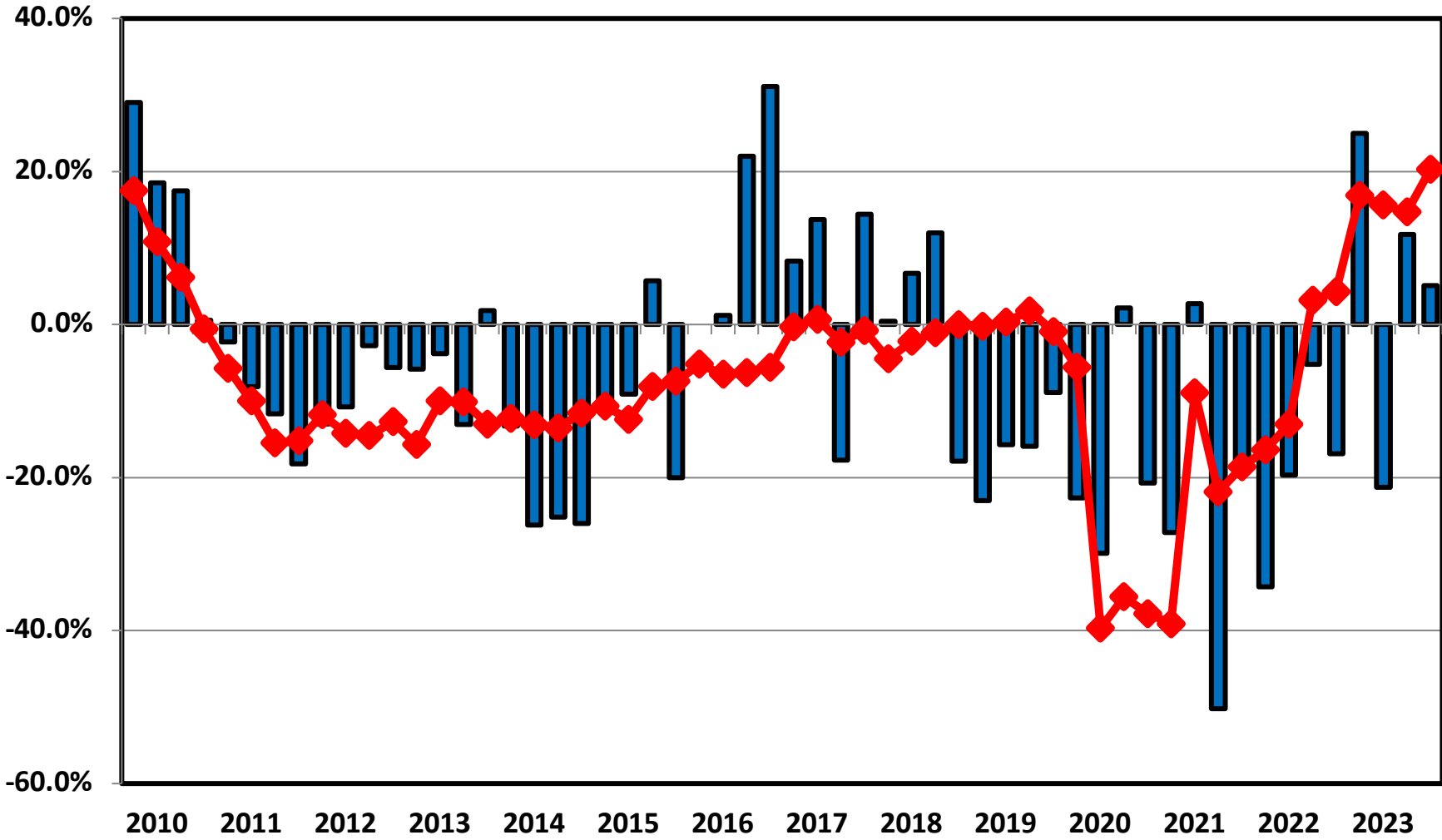


Unemployment Rate By Quarter 2006 - 2023

Filing Trends By Quarter Wyoming vs. National Average (Percent Change From Same Quarter One Year Prior)

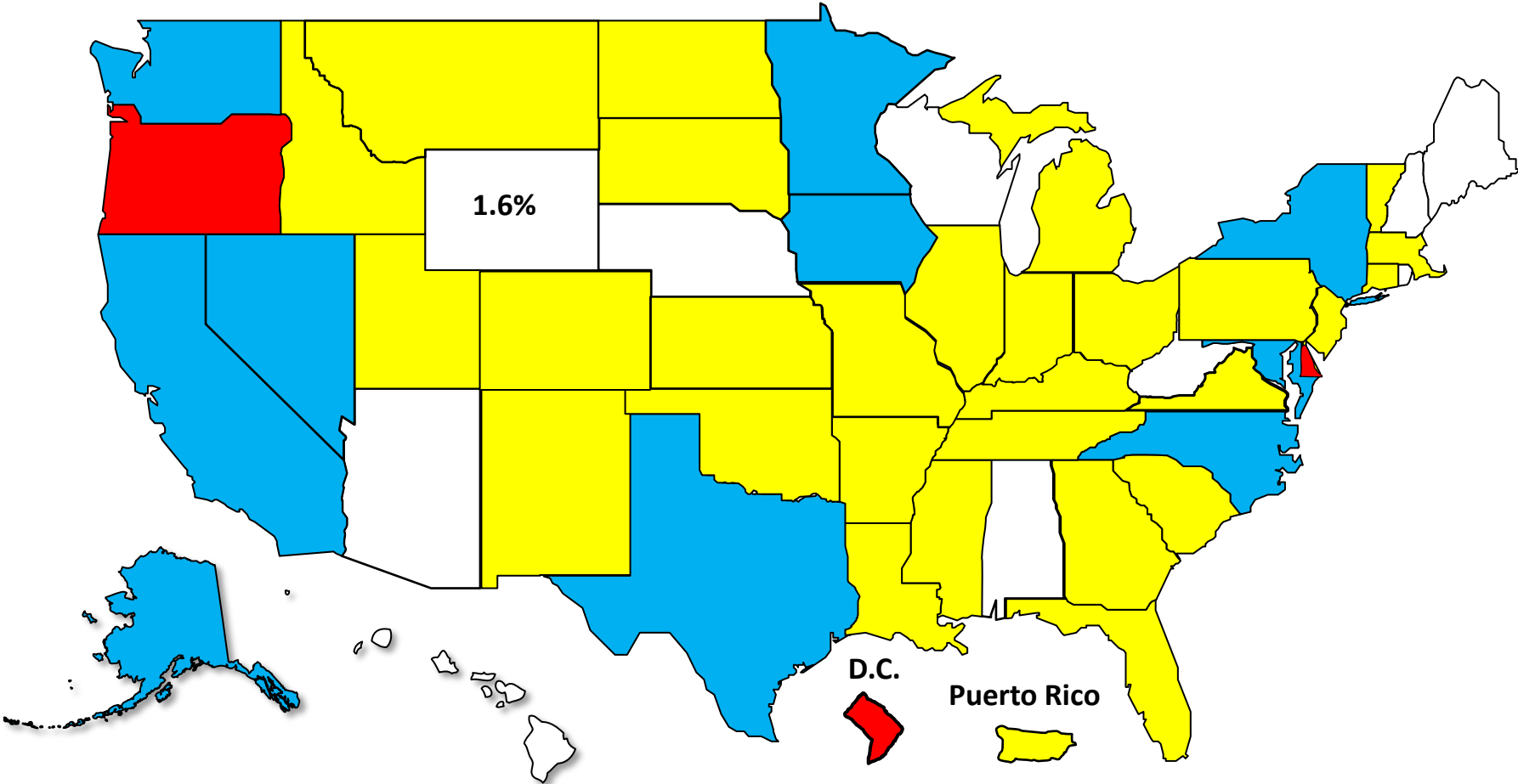

National Average = 16.8% Increase

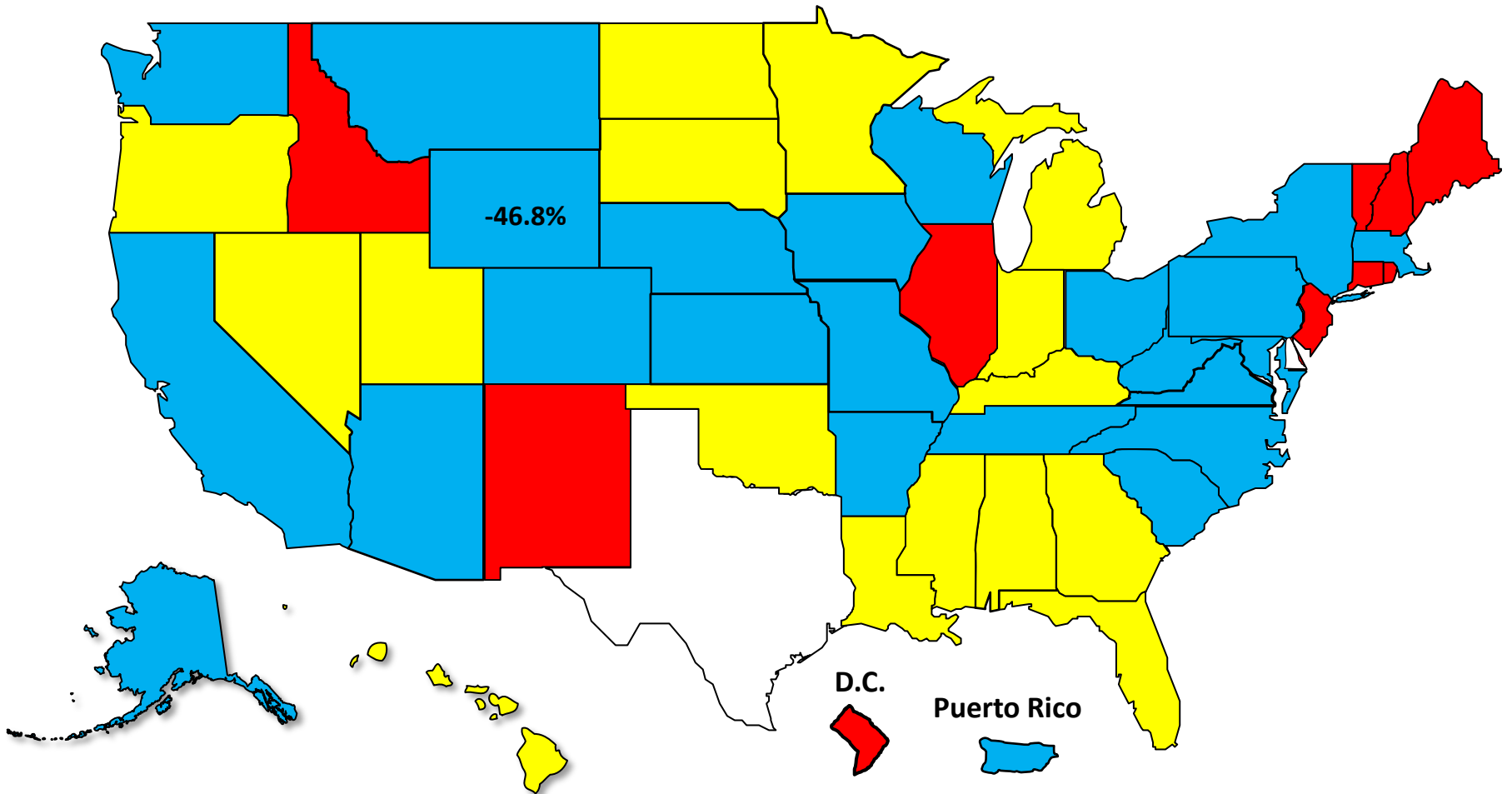


Bankruptcy Filing Trends During the Pandemic

Decline Under 30.0% Decline 30.0% – 39.9% Decline 40.0% – 49.9% Decline 50.0% or More

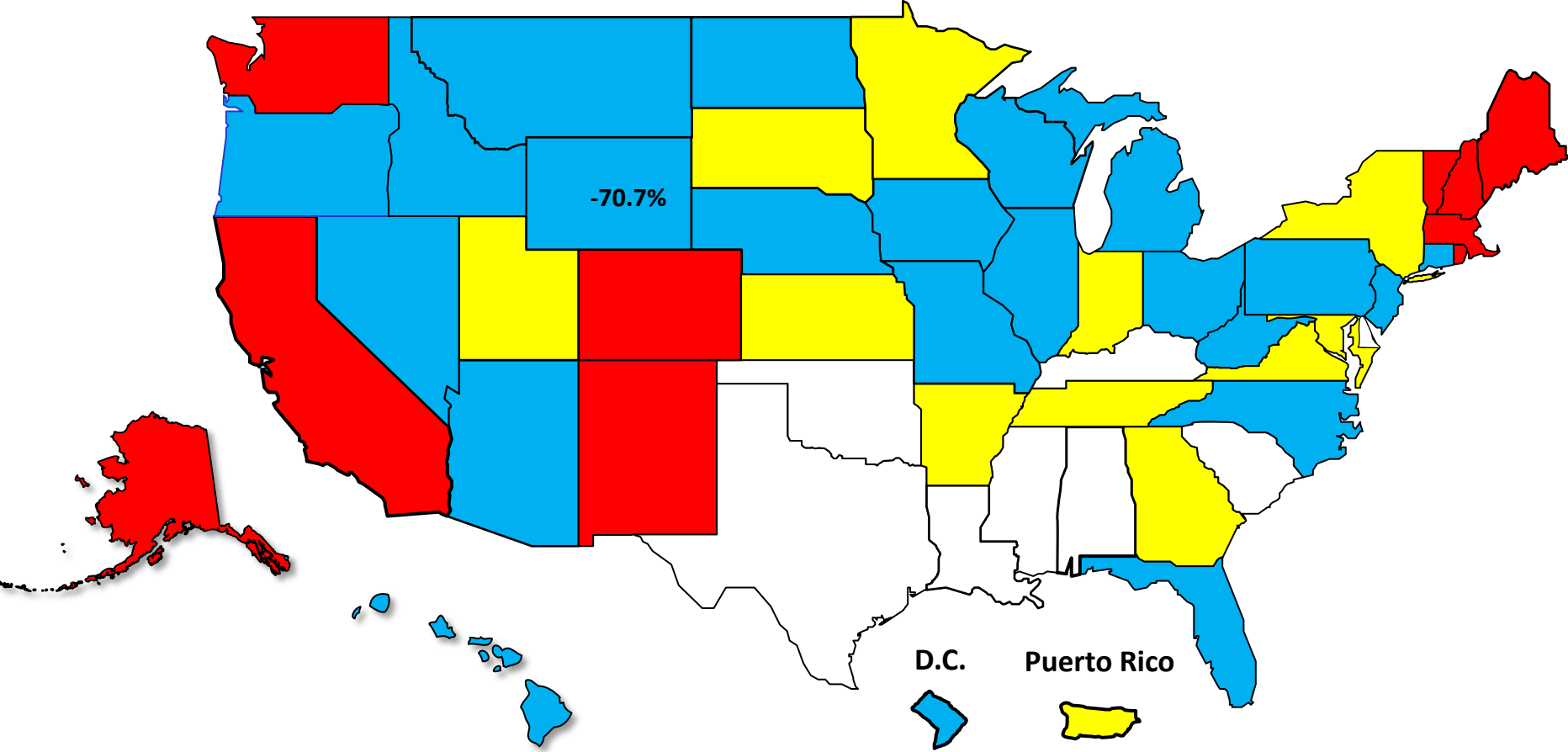


Percent Change in Total Filings
