


Establishments

Between March 2020 and March 2021, 8,644 Arkansas establishments opened and 7,558 closed, for a net increase of 1,086. Employment expanded at 16,633 establishments and contracted at 18,294. Small businesses accounted for 8,172 openings and 7,086 closings.


Employment

Opening and expanding Arkansas establishments added 99,893 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 118,221, for a net decrease of 18,328 jobs. Small businesses gained 72,165 jobs and lost 77,537, for a net decrease of 5,372 jobs.

Thousands of jobs





Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2020, reporting banks issued \$1.3 billion in loans to Arkansas businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$100,000 or less was \$1.1 billion. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$1 million or less was \$3.8 billion.



Small business exports

A total of 2,168 identified firms exported goods worth \$4.8 billion from Arkansas in 2020. Of those exporters, 1,676—or 77.3 percent—were small. Exports by small firms reached \$934.0 million, making up 19.6 percent of exports by identified firms.


