


Establishments

Between March 2020 and March 2021, 11,644 Kentucky establishments opened and 10,852 closed, for a net increase of 792. Employment expanded at 22,033 establishments and contracted at 27,987. Small businesses accounted for 11,033 openings and 10,100 closings.


Employment

Opening and expanding Kentucky establishments added 163,144 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 195,855, for a net decrease of 32,711 jobs. Small businesses gained 107,422 jobs and lost 128,358, for a net decrease of 20,936 jobs.

Thousands of jobs



Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2020, reporting banks issued \$1.1 billion in loans to Kentucky businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$100,000 or less was \$1.2 billion. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$1 million or less was \$4.3 billion.



Small business exports

A total of 4,542 identified firms exported goods worth \$23.3 billion from Kentucky in 2020. Of those exporters, 3,578—or 78.8 percent—were small. Exports by small firms reached \$3.2 billion, making up 13.9 percent of exports by identified firms.


