


Establishments

Between March 2020 and March 2021, 23,729 Michigan establishments opened and 22,834 closed, for a net increase of 895. Employment expanded at 43,009 establishments and contracted at 60,612. Small businesses accounted for 23,061 openings and 21,786 closings.


Employment

Opening and expanding Michigan establishments added 288,899 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 499,251, for a net decrease of 210,352 jobs. Small businesses gained 210,527 jobs and lost 331,462, for a net decrease of 120,935 jobs.

Thousands of jobs






Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2020, reporting banks issued \$3.2 billion in loans to Michigan businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$100,000 or less was \$3.3 billion. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$1 million or less was \$12.7 billion.



Small business exports

A total of 13,861 identified firms exported goods worth \$41.6 billion from Michigan in 2020. Of those exporters, 12,241—or 88.3 percent—were small. Exports by small firms reached \$9.8 billion, making up 23.5 percent of exports by identified firms.


