


Establishments

Between March 2020 and March 2021, 2,408 Vermont establishments opened and 2,488 closed, for a net decrease of 80. Employment expanded at 4,295 establishments and contracted at 5,616. Small businesses accounted for 2,281 establishment openings and 2,353 closings.


Employment

Opening and expanding Vermont establishments added 21,276 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 38,423, for a net decrease of 17,147 jobs. Small businesses gained 16,778 jobs and lost 28,050, for a net decrease of 11,272 jobs.

Thousands of establishments




Thousands of jobs

Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2020, reporting banks issued \$169.8 million in loans to Vermont businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. 

Small business exports

A total of 1,017 identified firms exported goods worth \$2.2 billion from Vermont in 2020. Of those exporters, 879—or 86.4 percent—were small. Exports by small firms reached \$475.0 million, making up 21.1 percent of exports by identified firms.


