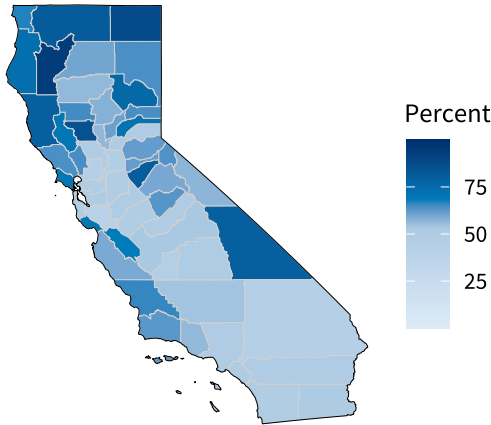

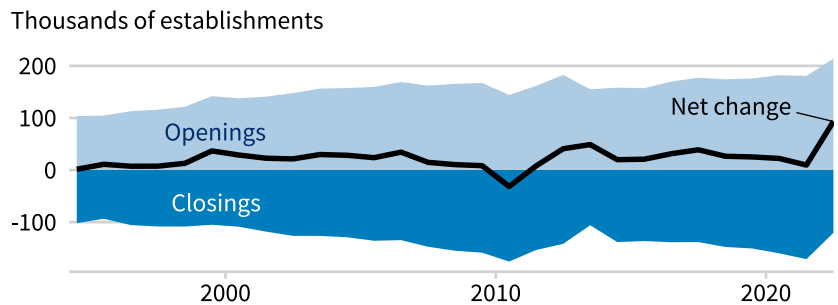
Share of employees working at small businesses by county

Business dynamics

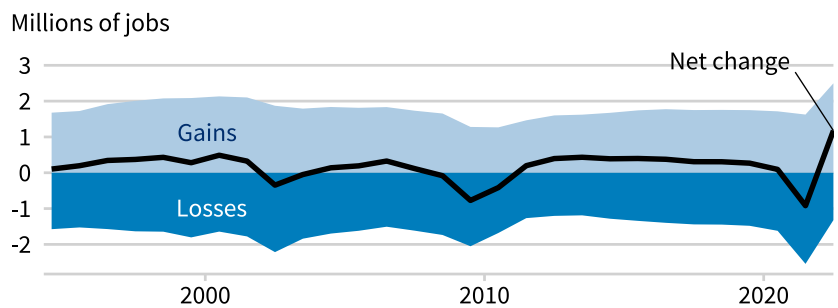
Establishments

Between March 2021 and March 2022, 213,893 California establishments opened and 120,730 closed, for a net increase of 93,163. Employment expanded at 318,767 establishments and contracted at 203,349. Small businesses accounted for 130,888 openings and 91,314 closings.



Employment

Opening and expanding California establishments added 2.5 million jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 1.3 million, for a net increase of 1.2 million jobs. Small businesses contributed a net increase of 769,454 jobs, or 65.5 percent of that total.

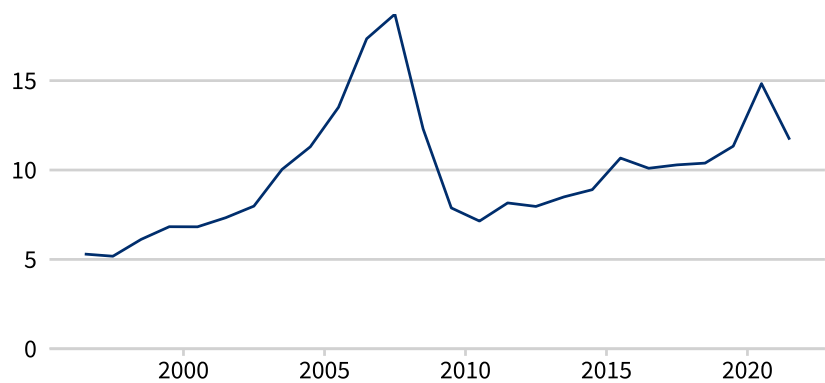
Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2021, reporting banks issued \$11.7 billion in loans to California businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$100,000 or less was \$18.1 billion. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$1 million or less was \$45.6 billion.

Small business exports

A total of 63,860 identified firms exported goods worth \$163.9 billion from California in 2021. Of those exporters, 60,700—or 95.1 percent—were small. Exports by small firms reached \$69.1 billion, making up 42.2 percent of exports by identified firms.

Women made up 45.7 percent of workers and owned 43.2 percent of businesses.

Veterans



Veterans made up 3.1 percent of workers and owned 4.1 percent of businesses.

Racial minorities made up 40.1 percent of workers and owned 28.3 percent of businesses.

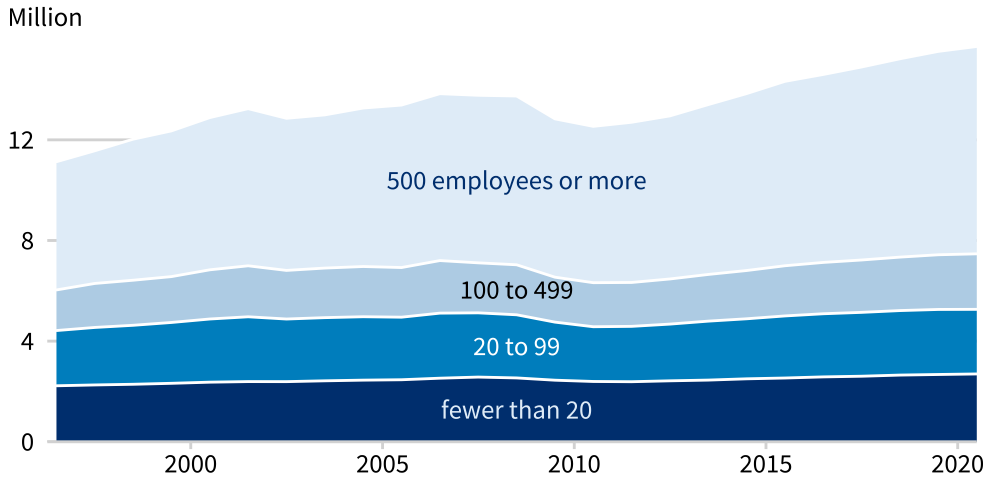
