


Establishments

Between March 2021 and March 2022, 7,508 Mississippi establishments opened and 5,524 closed, for a net increase of 1,984. Employment expanded at 16,687 establishments and contracted at 15,137. Small businesses accounted for 6,858 openings and 5,156 closings.


Employment

Opening and expanding Mississippi establishments added 118,871 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 84,244, for a net increase of 34,627 jobs. Small businesses contributed a net increase of 23,049 jobs, or 66.6 percent of that total.

Thousands of establishments




Thousands of jobs

Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2021, reporting banks issued \$967.8 million in loans to Mississippi businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. 

Small business exports

A total of 1,984 identified firms exported goods worth \$12.3 billion from Mississippi in 2021. Of those exporters, 1,514—or 76.3 percent—were small. Exports by small firms reached \$1.8 billion, making up 14.5 percent of exports by identified firms.


