

Business dynamics


Establishments

Between March 2021 and March 2022, 8,378 New Hampshire establishments opened and 5,194 closed, for a net increase of 3,184. Employment expanded at 13,343 establishments and contracted at 9,809. Small businesses accounted for 7,732 openings and 4,735 closings.


Employment

Opening and expanding New Hampshire establishments added 76,736 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 49,848, for a net increase of 26,888 jobs. Small businesses contributed a net increase of 22,919 jobs, or 85.2 percent of that total.

Thousands of establishments




Thousands of jobs

Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2021, reporting banks issued \$401.4 million in loans to New Hampshire businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. 

Small business exports

A total of 2,497 identified firms exported goods worth \$6.1 billion from New Hampshire in 2021. Of those exporters, 2,159—or 86.5 percent—were small. Exports by small firms reached \$2.3 billion, making up 37.5 percent of exports by identified firms.


