


Establishments

Between March 2021 and March 2022, 7,270 New Mexico establishments opened and 5,695 closed, for a net increase of 1,575. Employment expanded at 13,519 establishments and contracted at 10,273. Small businesses accounted for 6,786 openings and 5,352 closings.


Employment

Opening and expanding New Mexico establishments added 101,119 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 63,710, for a net increase of 37,409 jobs. Small businesses contributed a net increase of 24,996 jobs, or 66.8 percent of that total.

Thousands of establishments




Thousands of jobs

Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2021, reporting banks issued \$372.2 million in loans to New Mexico businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. 

Small business exports

A total of 1,325 identified firms exported goods worth \$5.3 billion from New Mexico in 2021. Of those exporters, 1,112—or 83.9 percent—were small. Exports by small firms reached \$2.5 billion, making up 46.1 percent of exports by identified firms.


