


Establishments

Between March 2021 and March 2022, 18,513 Oregon establishments opened and 15,528 closed, for a net increase of 2,985. Employment expanded at 37,371 establishments and contracted at 28,363. Small businesses accounted for 17,483 openings and 14,795 closings.


Employment

Opening and expanding Oregon establishments added 226,271 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 157,368, for a net increase of 68,903 jobs. Small businesses contributed a net increase of 55,304 jobs, or 80.3 percent of that total.

Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2021, reporting banks issued \$1.2 billion in loans to Oregon businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$100,000 or less was \$1.4 billion. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$1 million or less was \$4.0 billion.




Small business exports

A total of 5,672 identified firms exported goods worth \$29.1 billion from Oregon in 2021. Of those exporters, 4,976—or 87.7 percent—were small. Exports by small firms reached \$5.5 billion, making up 19.0 percent of exports by identified firms.


