

Business dynamics


Establishments

Between March 2021 and March 2022, 3,239 Wyoming establishments opened and 2,443 closed, for a net increase of 796. Employment expanded at 5,785 establishments and contracted at 4,891. Small businesses accounted for 3,002 establishment openings and 2,319 closings.


Employment

Opening and expanding Wyoming establishments added 27,392 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 19,567, for a net increase of 7,825 jobs. Small businesses contributed a net increase of 6,520 jobs, or 83.3 percent of that total.

Thousands of establishments




Thousands of jobs

Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2021, reporting banks issued \$227.4 million in loans to Wyoming businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. 

Small business exports

A total of 507 identified firms exported goods worth \$1.4 billion from Wyoming in 2021. Of those exporters, 418—or 82.4 percent—were small. Exports by small firms reached \$871.0 million, making up 63.9 percent of exports by identified firms.


