Ev@lang is an online language skill assessment tool. Fast and accurate, it will determine your level so you know what class, test or exam you should take.



Apolearn is a connected learning platform where students access classes, activities and online content prepared by their instructors. Flexibility, continuity and autonomy in learning are made available through this platform.



Frello is an online resource that allows instructors to tailor an online "textbook" specific to student's needs.



Culturethèque is an e-library service that allows students to read eBooks, comic books, children's picture books and magazines; consult French language learning materials; listen to concerts and interviews.

OPTION 1: FOUNDATION FRENCH

Our regular adult group classes are perfect to start any training at an entry or beginner level. Our standard method and general curriculum allow for a solid program to develop all skills (speaking, listening, reading, writing and interacting) using Cosmopolite texts and activity books and extra online material.

Regular Option: one sublevel, two 1.5-hour classes per week over 10 weeks,

Fast-Track A1 option: (three sublevels A1.1 to A1.3) two 3-hour classes per week over 15 weeks starting in Sept 2021 and Jan 2022.

Fast-Track A2 option: (4 sublevels A2.1 to A2.4) two 3-hour classes per week over 20 weeks starting in Sept 2021 and Jan 2022.

The content includes thematic vocabulary, grammatical structures, functional expressions and oral communication techniques. It is aimed at helping participants develop the communicative and linguistic skills.

Prerequisites: A2 confirmed (intermediate)

To confirm an A2 level of proficiency, the online placement test Ev@lang is available. (\$20.00)

Online part-time training scheduled on Mondays and Fridays from 10:00 am to 11:00 am .

1-hour twice a week over 4 weeks and individual access to 4 hours of online material for a total of 12 hours of training.
