
Hello Brett. I wanted to make you and the Idaho Attorney General's Office aware of the following in case you get contacted about it.

BCI was notified on Friday December 3, 2021, that one of its external review vendors experienced a data breach on November 9, 2021, impacting twenty-two (22) BCI members, ten (10) of whom reside in Idaho. On Sunday December 5, 2021, we learned that social security numbers may have been included in the data breached. At this time, it appears that the vendor was able to recover the data without the data being misused. The vendor will be providing affected members with a personalized notification letter and free credit monitoring consistent with HIPAA requirements.

We anticipate that member notification will occur in the near future and will provide you with additional information, including a copy of the member notification letter, once it is received.
