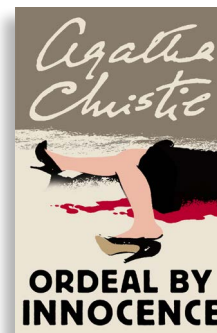
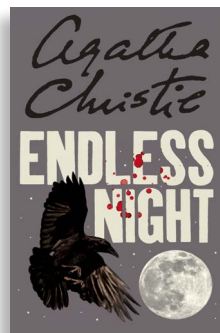
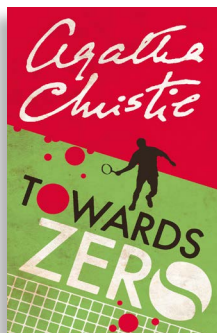
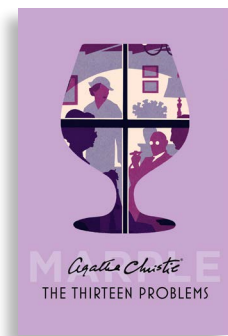
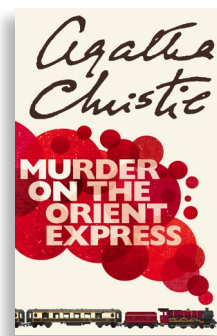
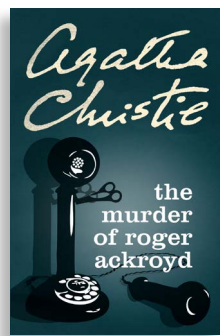
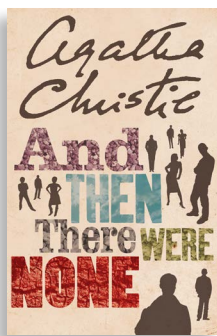
Agatha Christie's 10 Favourite Books
