Colonel Jason K. Jefferis Deputy Commander- Overseas Operations

Colonel Jason K. Jefferis serves as the Deputy Commander for Overseas Operations (DC-OO) of the U.S. Army Contracting Command (ACC), headquartered at Redstone Arsenal, Alabama.

As the DC-OO, Col. Jefferis is responsible for the training, manning and operations of six contracting support brigades, four contracting battalions and eight contracting detachments that are aligned with Army service component commands comprised of more than 1,200 military and civilian personnel who execute over 40,000 contracts worth more than \$2 billion annually. He provides strategic and tactical contract planning and expertise to support large scale Army and joint military operations. He also serves as the senior contracting official for all OCONUS Army contracting support brigades.

Prior to joining ACC, Col. Jefferis served as the designated Head of Contracting Activity for Headquarters, United States Army Corps of Engineers, in Washington, D.C.



Over the course of his career, he has held numerous command and staff positions across the acquisition enterprise including: Senior Contracting Official and Director of Contracting, Mission and Installation Contracting Command Field Directorate Office, Joint Base San Antonio, Texas; Deputy Director for Resource Management and Senior Procurement Advisor, Combined Security Transition Command-Afghanistan/Resolute Support, Kabul, Afghanistan; Deputy Chief of Staff, G-2/3/5/7 for the Mission and Installation Contracting Command, Joint Base San Antonio, Texas; Commander, 902nd Contracting Battalion, Joint Base Lewis-McChord, Washington; Director of Procurement Support, Office of the Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Army (Procurement), Washington, D.C.; Military Assistant to the Director, Defense Contract Management Agency, Alexandria, Virginia; Commander, Defense Contract Management Agency-Albuquerque, Kirtland Air Force Base, New Mexico; Lead Administrative Contracting Officer for the Defense Contract Management Agency-Northern Afghanistan, Operation Enduring Freedom; Contracting Officer, Light Combat and Diagnostics Division, and later Deputy Executive for Contracting, TACOM Life Cycle Management Command Acquisition Center at Rock Island Arsenal, Illinois, and Operation Iraqi Freedom.

Col. Jefferis was commissioned as a Field Artillery Officer in 1996 from the United States Military Academy at West Point, New York, where he earned a Bachelor's Degree in Economics. His advanced education includes a Master of Business Administration from Auburn University, a Master of Arts in Management from Webster University, and a Master of Science in National Resource Strategy from the Eisenhower School at the National Defense University.

His military decorations include the Legion of Merit, Bronze Star Medal, Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Meritorious Service Medal, Joint Service Commendation Medal, Army Commendation Medal, Joint Service Achievement Medal, Army Achievement Medal, Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, Iraq/Afghanistan Campaign Medals, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, Armed Forces Service Medal and the Humanitarian Service Medal. He is authorized to wear the Parachutist Badge and Air Assault Badge. He was also the recipient of the 2007 Army Material Command Frank S. Besson Award for Contracting Excellence and the 2020 Secretary of the Army Contingency Contracting Unit of the Year.
