

Public Notice of City of Pittsburgh Comprehensive Municipal Pension Trust Fund  
Selection of Professional Service Provider

September 5, 2024

The City of Pittsburgh Comprehensive Municipal Pension Trust Fund (“CMPTF”) issued a Request for Proposals (“RFP”) on August 7, 2024. CMPTF sought proposals from qualified providers to serve as a Pension Payment Processing and Check and Tax Form Print Production Service Provider (“PP & CP”).

After a thorough review of each of the subsequently received proposals at the Meeting of the Board of Trustees (“Board”) of the CMPTF on September 5, 2024, the CMPTF elected to retain the Pittsburgh City Controller’s Office (“City Controller”) for the role because of the following reasons: City Controller provided a competitive fee proposal, at a rate lower than other proposals. Further, City Controller has a proven track record of providing PP & CP services. City Controller has provided the services necessary for this role for boards within the CMPTF since 2007.
