



# Sophos MDR 'a light at the end of the tunnel' for Bloxham School in Oxfordshire

Bloxham School is an independent day and boarding school, based in the large village of Bloxham in Oxfordshire, and is part of the Woodard Schools group. The school has a main site, with two boarding houses based in other locations within the village. The pupil base of around 650 children, between the ages of 11 and 18, attend the school either as day students or boarding. There are around 300 staff, which includes teachers, administration and support staff.

Oxfordshire-based independent Bloxham School has been a Sophos customer since 2018. Aware of an increase in malware and cyberattacks on educational institutions, Bloxham School sought to bolster its cybersecurity and threat protection, and turned to the Sophos Managed Detection and Response (MDR) team for help.

## Business challenges

Bloxham School already had Microsoft 365 A5 endpoint protection in place to protect its students, staff and 1,000 endpoints. Yet, with the rise in cyberattacks and ransomware threats, including the risk of internal hacking in the school network, the IT team wanted to strengthen its cybersecurity to cover the school 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Bloxham School has around 650 students and 300 staff, and every student and teacher is provided with a laptop. In addition, for sixth form students, the school runs a ‘bring your own device’ scheme to help prepare students for university. The school accommodates both day students and boarders, so a significant number of students require access to the network outside of school hours. The threat of an attack from a hacker within the school network was also a real possibility.

In 2023, the school’s Director of IT, Dave Quinney, acknowledged that his team did not have the capacity and expertise to monitor and protect the school’s IT infrastructure 24/7/365, or respond in the event of a malware or ransomware attack. With the IT team concerned about the vulnerability the school faced, Dave sought to find a solution to strengthen the team’s ability to respond to cyber threats. Having concluded that doing this in-house would be unaffordable and unfeasible, he began to explore other options.

The school considered four cybersecurity providers. In most cases, the quotes were well beyond the school’s budget, or the solutions offered were incompatible with those the school was already under contract for. Sophos, however, came through with a solution that ticked all the right boxes.
