







IMPORTANT PLEASE READ

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS :

ASSEMBLY :

- 1. Carefully remove all parts from the box and remove all the plastic covering.
- 2. Please find the corresponding numbered parts before you assemble the mirror.
- 3. Please draw a horizontal line in the corresponding position of the wall.
- 4. Fix the wall bracket (1) on the horizontal line on the wall with screws and plugs (2), ensures an accurate installation.
- 5. Hang the mirror body (A) on the wall bracket (1).
- 6. Assembly is complete.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

Dust often using a soft, dry cloth. Blot spills immediately, and wipe with a clean, soft, dry cloth. We do not recommend the use of chemical cleansers, abrasives, or furniture polish on our lacquered finish.

Use placemats or trivets under hot items and coasters under beverages to prevent marks and stains.

To avoid scratches, do not place sharp or jagged objects directly on the tabletop.
