CONTINUATION OF NARRATIVE

He was bleeding from the head area. The victim was wearing a navy blue blazer, a blue shirt, a maroon and blue pokadot tie, gray pants, gray socks, and black shoes.

At about 2318 hrs the East Chicago Emergency Medical Service Ambulance arrived on the scene. They gave emergency treatment to the victim and transported him to St. Catherine Hospital.

Deputy Chief John Cardona was on the scene when I arrived. He advised me to protect the scene and keep people away. Shortly after, another squad arrived. Chief Cardona then advised me that he had a witness and to take him aside and get any and all information that he might have. I took the witness to my car for a statement. The witness is one Mark Warholic M/W/28 of 823 N Lillian Ct. Griffith, Indiana TX #924-2637. This witness gave me the following statement.

He stated that he came down the stairs from the Elks Club located on the second floor of the building to the Jockey Club located on the first floor. He stated that he didn't see anyone in the hallway at this point. He stated he was in the Jockey Club for about five (5) minutes. He left the Jockey Club bar room to go to the bathroom located in the hallway just outside the Jockey Club doors. When he was between the Jockey Club Bar and the bathroom he noticed the victim and another man standing in the vestibule shoulder to shoulder talking.

The other man was described to me as being a male subject dressed in a gray suit a little taller than the victim with black curly hair, and huskier.

The witness entered the bathroom. After entering the bathroom he heard a (pop). Upon hearing the pop he exited the bathroom and saw the victim laying between the entrance doors. At this time he yelled to someone in the bar to call the ambulance and the police. He then went to the entrance and observed the victim laying face down with his head against the entrance door and bleeding.

The witness was then turned over to Chief Cardona and transported to central station.

Another witness I talked to was one John Fortener M/W/39 of 4619 Magoun Ave. He stated that he parked his car in front of Lipman Clothing store located on the north east corner of Chicago Ave. & Magoun Ave's. He stated that he heard a sound that sounded like a shot and thought it came from Sardi's tap located on the south east corner. He further stated that he didn't see anyone leaving the area.

At about 2317 Hrs. the inspector was called and at 2318 Hrs. the coroner was notified. The inspectors arrived on the scene at about 2330 Hrs. The inspectors are Paul Dichara of the East Chicago Police Dept., and inspector E Sifel unit #227. The inspectors at this time took charge of the scene.

The Coroners team and Potographer arrived between 2330 Hrs and 2400 Hrs. The corpners were Pete Candiano team leader, Charles Wells acting team leader, James Brunley, levi Hicks, and photogropher Mark Allen.

The ambulance was E.M.S. 101 operated Capt. Carolyn Smith, Alfonso Lerma, and Sandy Michalak. The Doctor attending was Dr Sontos who pronounced the victim dead at 2333 Hrs on 5-15-81.

The identity of the victim was varified at the hospital by his personal effects and his Drivers Lic.

NOTE: My observation at the scene was a body as discribed and what appeared to be a bullet whole in the window of the outside door on the right side facing the building.

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ITEM NO. At 2314 Hrs on 5-15-81 I, SGT R. Jackson, received a dispatch on on a Code-10 at the Elks Club located at 4624 Magoun. Upon my arrival I was met by Lt Ziller, Det Sandy Ligon, and Deputy Chief John Cardona who were all standing in the front entrance doorway (East) behind a male white person who was lying on the floor of the entrance of the Elks Club bleeding from the head area. Lt Robert Ziller at this time advised me to call the inspector and the coroner. He advised that Lt Ziller, Det Ligon and Chief Cardona were all off duty at the time. I at this time went back to my squad and advised central to notify the technician and the coroner. Upon further investigation, the male white subject who was lying on the floor between the glass outer doors and the inner doors was lying face down in a pool of blood with his head facing East and his feet facing West. The subject was wearing a blue blazer, grey pants and black shoes. I then immediately began to protect the scene. At approx 2318 Hrs same date the East Chicago EMS arrived, occupied by EMS technicians Carolyn Smith, Alfonso Lerma, and Sandy Michalak. They at this time gave emergency treatment to the victim and transported him to St Catherines Hospital.

ITEM NO. At approx 2330 Hrs same date Technicians Paul DiCharia and Ed Sifel of the East Chicago Police Dept. arrived at the scene. I then at this time turned the scene over to Technician Paul DiCharia, and Ed Sifel who took photos and collected all evidence. I then began to look for witness's to the incident. I located a one Gussie Tsouchlos F/Wage 23 of 573 Ingraham St in Calumet City Ill., Tx 862-7943 or 392-0846, and a one Thomas A. Zimmerman M/W of 504 Forsythe Ave, Calumet City, Ill, Tx ~~882-7111~~ 882-7111. Both stated that they didn't see anything but that they were in the bar area which is located approx 50' feet West of the East entrance, when they heard what sounded like one gunshot. I at this time turned these two subjects over to Officer J. Kelly for further investigation. See Officer Kelly's report for further information.

At approx 2345 Hrs the Lake County Coroner's team and photographer arrived at the scene. The team consisted of Pete Candiano, who was team leader, Charles Wells, James Brunley, Levi Hicks, and photographer Mark Allen. They at this time measured off the crime scene and took photos of same. After doing so they they proceeded to St Catherines Hosp where the victim had been taken.

Upon viewing the bullet hole from the glass of the door there is what appears to be brain tissue and substance just below the hole. There is a set of six keys lying on the floor along with a white plastic Bic lighter located approximately 10" inches west of the glass doors, directly in the center of said doors. According to Sgt. Jackson he stated that these items were the Victim's. The keys and the lighter were identified as belonging to the Victim. Moving through the two wood doors into the lobby and looking to the immediate left, there are three cigarette butts lying on the floor next to the basement doors. Two of the cigarette butts are Marlboro's Lights and one appears to be a light menthol of the type smoked by the Victim. At this point I requested more officers on the scene in the attempt to search the premises. After completing the inside scene search, the search for additional evidence was concentrated outside on Magoun Ave. On the pavement approximately 56' ft. 3" inches north of the doors of the Elks Club and approximately 9' ft. 8" inches east of the west curb, there is a 45 caliber spent Projectile ball ammunition.
