

Cehupa Winter Count — a generous donor made it possible to have the Gunderson Cehupa Winter Count preserved with plans to display it in the museum. The Winter Count covers 111 years of history, 1798-1908. The Lakota tradition of creating pictorial calendars was a way of recording tribal records and events and served as a way to pass down a family history from one generation to the next.
