# 21.99.04.B1 Disposition of Abandoned and Unclaimed Personal Property

## **Rule Summary**

- The Texas Division of Emergency Management will dispose of abandoned and unclaimed property.
- The Rule is required by Texas A&M University System Regulation 21.99.04.

#### **Definitions**

 Abandoned or Unclaimed Property – Personal property is considered abandoned or unclaimed if the identity or the valid address of the owner cannot be determined from the information available to the holder of the property.

#### Rule

- 1. Abandoned or Unclaimed Property will be handled by the employees of the Division in the following manner:
  - 1.1 Released to the owner of the property upon receipt and verification of ownership unless the property is being held for the purpose of a criminal investigation or pending criminal prosecution.
  - 1.2 Released to law enforcement personnel if the property is determined to be evidence in a criminal investigation or pending criminal prosecution.
  - 1.3 When the owner of the property is known, the Division shall notify the owner by mail, telephone, e-mail or other means within forty-five (45) days.
  - 1.4 If, after ninety (90) days of holding the abandoned and unclaimed property, the property has not been claimed, the Division will dispose of the property following Division surplus property guidelines.
