When you start your MacBook Pro for the first time. Setup Assistant launches to get you going. Follow a few simple steps to connect to your Wi-Fi network transfer your stuff from another Mac or a PC, create a user account for your Mac, and log in with your Apple ID.

### Multi-Touch gestures

Many functions on your MacBook Pro can be performed using simple gestures on the trackpad. Here are some of the most popular Multi-Touch gestures for the Mac.



Press down anywhere on the trackpac to click. Or, with Tap to Click enabled simply tap the surface.

#### Get to know your desktop

#### iCloud



forth between pages. Double-tap with two fingers to magnify a page then double-tap again to return to the original size. Or pinch to zoom in and out.






