Let's get started

Press the power button to start up your MacBook Pro, and Setup Assistant You can do a lot of things on your MacBook Pro using simple gestures on the trackpad. Here are some of the most popular ones. guides you through a few simple steps to get you up and running guickly It walks you through connecting to your Wi-Fi network and creating a user account for your Mac. And it can even transfer your documents, email, photos, music, and movies to your new Mac from another Mac or PC.

You can sign in with your Apple ID in Setup Assistant. This automatically sets up your account in the Mac App Store and the iTunes Store, and in apps like Messages and FaceTime, so they're ready the first time you open them. It also sets up iCloud, so apps such as Mail, Contacts, Calendar, and Safari have all your latest information waiting for you.
