## U.S. ARMY COMMUNICATIONS-ELECTRONICS COMMAND

### Ms. Liz S. Miranda

Detailed as Deputy to the Commanding General



Ms. Liz S. Miranda assumed the responsibility detailed as Deputy to the Commanding General, Communications-Electronics Command (CECOM) in October 2022. She previously served as the Director of the CECOM Integrated Logistics Supply Center (ILSC) from November 2015.

She was selected to the Senior Executive Service effective 8 January 2017.

As Director of the CECOM ILSC, Ms. Miranda served as the command's senior leader in developing a vision, strategy and implementation plans necessary to achieve an integrated enterprise approach to logistics for Command, Control, Communications, Computers, Cyber, Intelligence, Surveillance and Reconnaissance (C5ISR) weapon systems.

Ms. Miranda provided leadership and guidance to a global organization of more than 2,000 employees in over 20 countries and 100 sites, with an annual budget in excess of \$1.2B. She led the eight directorates that form the ILSC in core competencies of national inventory control point, national maintenance point, life cycle & logistics support planning, production & industrial base management, field training & technical assistance, performance-based logistics, security assistance to allied nations, and communications security (COMSEC) logistics.

Ms. Miranda's previous assignments include serving as Director of the CECOM Deputy Chief of Staff for Resource Management/G8, where she was the principal and top advisor to the Commanding General for integrated planning, programming, budgeting, financial management and execution of the command's estimated annual budget of \$3B and over 7,600 civilian and military manpower authorizations. She also served as the Executive Officer to the Deputy to the Commanding General for Operations and Support, Chief of the Reset Plans and Execution Branch in the Logistics and Readiness Center (LRC), and Deputy Chief of the Army Reprogramming Analysis Team (ARAT) Program Office in the Software Engineering Center (SEC).

Ms. Miranda holds a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration with concentration in Accounting from the University of Puerto Rico and a Master of Science in Management from the Florida Institute of Technology. She is a graduate of the APG Senior Leadership Cohort Program and the CECOM Executive Development Program. She is a member of the Army Acquisition Corps, Level III certified in Business, Cost Estimating and Financial Management and has achieved DoD Financial Management Level III certification.

Ms. Miranda is a member of the American Society of Military Comptrollers and the Armed Forces Communications Electronics Association (AFCEA).
