## NONINSTRUCTIONAL OPERATIONS

## **Hours of Service of Drivers**

To promote the safety of students riding in school buses, the Dietrich School District is implementing this policy concerning bus driver maximum drive time. It is the policy of the District that bus drivers, or any district employee providing transportation for students, shall adhere to the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration regulations. Currently those regulations provide a maximum of ten (10) hours of actual driving time. Drivers must have eight (8) hours of continuous off duty time before long trips and cannot exceed sixty (60) hours of driving in a week.

Drivers shall use FMCSA over-the-road hours-of-service trip logs, a trip agenda, or other trip documentation validating applicable driving hours on all out-of-District trips in excess of one-hundred (100) miles.
