ASA – CoRAI – ARA operational programme 2024

Background:

Following the adoption of the Working Agreement on a Strategic Partnership for a Just and Sustainable Transition of European Automotive Regions ("Agreement") between the Automotive Regions Alliance ("ARA"), the Interregional Group "Future of the Automotive Industry" of the European Committee of the Regions ("CoRAI") and Automotive Skills Alliance ("ASA") in Pamplona, Navarra in November 2023, the parties declared their will to develop further joint activities and events throughout the year of 2024. Earlier in 2022 during the first ARA Annual Conference in Leipzig, the regions of ARA, ASA and CoRAI expressed their interest to cooperate towards the just transition of the automotive ecosystems and acknowledged the importance of the up- and reskilling as a contribution to the European Skills Agenda and Pact for Skills initiative.

To fulfil objectives of the Agreement in terms of supporting each other, taking advantages of opportunities to act together and jointly representing and advocating for the agreed objectives, this document sets up priorities of regional cooperation for a just and sustainable transition.

In 2024, the parties will focus on the following objectives of the cooperation and planned events:

Cooperation objectives:

- Call on the European Commission, in the light of its commitment under the Regulation on CO2 emission standards for cars, to carry out a detailed territorial impact assessment without delay and to prepare a report on the needs, challenges and funding gaps for a just transition in the automotive and automotive supply industry in Europe by the end of 2025
- Contribute with an input to the future EU skills agenda and regional skills transformation for EU automotive regions
- Formulate and voice the priorities of ASA, CORAI and ARA for the new European Parliament and European Commission following the 2024 European election
- Join forces at the number of occasions based on the roadmap specified in this document
- Identify concrete and tangible policy measures, based on exchange of good practices in the EU on a regional level to facilitate and speed up the transformation of the automotive sector
