

he FGV School of Social Sciences/CPDOC is a preeminent teaching and research center focused on the social sciences and contemporary history. Created in 1973, the center is a part of Getulio Vargas Foundation (FGV), a prestigious Brazilian research and higher education institution since 1944. Over the years, CPDOC has become a leading historical research institute, housing an extensive collection of personal archives, oral history interviews and audiovisual sources that document Brazilian contemporary history.

Long recognized for its commitment to the integration of history and the social sciences, CPDOC has strengthened its applied research initiatives in recent years. The School encourages diverse approaches to learning reflected in both its faculty profile and cross-disciplinary curricula.

CPDOC is a diverse intellectual community of scholars, technicians and students who collaborate on a host of research programs, applied research consulting, teaching, and active partnership work with other FGV schools and institutes.




Teaching and Research

PDOC offers both undergraduate and graduate degrees and provides a variety of continuing education programs.

Students majoring in Social Sciences and History may concentrate their study on specific areas of expertise, such as politics and society, culture and society, and international relations. The center provides additional training in applied research and audiovisual and documentary production.

CPDOC offers two-year master's and four-year doctoral program in History, Politics and Culture. Academic backgrounds represented among our faculty encompass a variety of fields including: political history, international relations and global history, sociology and social thought, anthropology, political science, comparative politics, urban studies, research methods, public policy, social history, cultural history, and applied research. The faculty is committed to expanding existing ties with scholars outside Brazil, and in recent years have established partnerships with several well-renowned international institutions.

To foster the development of young academics and practitioners in growing subfields, CPDOC also offers professional graduate programs and continuing education courses in Documentary Film, Cultural Production and Management, and International Relations. All courses are offered in Rio de Janeiro, as well as a select few at the FGV center in Sao Paulo.




The Center for International Relations

n 2009, the Center of International Relations of FGV, based at the Social Sciences & History School/CPDOC, was founded, with the objectives of advancing research, promoting public debate, offering a teaching program, and adding value to the internationalization process of the FGV Foundation. Through the Center, CPDOC has been able to offer course on the history and theory of international relations to all FGV undergraduate students.
