

Hazardous Waste Program Hazardous Waste Generator Waste Storage Extension Request

Important: In accordance with 40 CFR 262.17(b) and 40 CFR 262.16(d) (as incorporated by reference in ARM 17.53.601), large and small quantity generators of hazardous waste may request an extension to waste storage time limits if waste must remain on-site longer than 90 days (for LQG) or 180/270 days (for SQG). The delay must be due to unforeseen, temporary, and uncontrollable circumstances. DEQ may grant a 30-day extension on a case-by-case basis. The request must be submitted before waste accumulation limits are reached. A generator may comply with 40 CFR 262.17(b) or 40 CFR 262.16(d) by submitting this form to DEQ.
