He expressed his understanding that they may be at the vigil for the recent death of a Deputy Sheriff that is occurring at the same time as this meeting. He referenced a prior conversation with Patrick Thomas, Legal Counsel, regarding a complaint filed with the Sherriff's Office for which the response was that it was an inadequate complaint. In response to a question from Rebecca Guay, Legal Counsel, Ms. Lane confirmed that the complaint was sent to to Captain Stichbury. Ms. Guay stressed the need to ensure complaints are investigated by the appropriate LEA and then Administrative Charging Committee for its review and consideration based on a query from Eddie James, Member. Pursuant to a query from Mr. James, Ms. confirmed that an LEA must investigate the complaints they receive.
