- Jacob Hayhurst (35 goals, 63 assists) is two points shy of 100 for his professional career.
- Kansas City's 14 wins against Mountain Division opponents are tied for the most victories by a team against one division this season.

#### News & Notes

- Wednesday night saw one of the most electric nights in recent memory at Cable Dahmer Arena, with a 7-5 Mavericks victory over Idaho.
- With three goals and an assist, Max Andreev recorded the second-highest single-game point total in team history.
- The rookie's hat trick was the first by a KC skater since Jeremy McKenna on Oct. 22, 2022.
- Kansas City opened the scoring on Wednesday night. The Mavericks are 11-2-0 when scoring first this season, one of only two teams with double-digit wins in that scenario this season.
- Assisting on Andreev's third goal was Cole Coskey, who had two total assists for his 100th professional point.
- Cade Borchardt and David Cotton recorded three assists each. It was Borchardt's sixth multi-point game of the season. Cotton's performance came in his home debut.
- It was a back-and-forth game between the two division rivals with Idaho scoring three unanswered to begin the third period, before Kyle Jackson, Nate Knoepke and Patrick Curry scored three-straight of their own to put the game out of reach.

   The Mavericks secured a 3-2 overtime victory at Maine on Saturday night.
- Nolan Walker ended overtime just 48 seconds into the extra frame with his second goal of the game.
- Also against Maine on Saturday, Patrick Curry had a goal and an assist for his fifth multi-point game of 2023-24.
- Max Andreev finished the month of November with 15 points in 12 games, en route to winning November's ECHL Rookie of the Month award.

#### MAX ANDREEV NAMED NOVEMBER'S **ECHL ROOKIE OF THE MONTH**

**INDEPENDENCE, MO. –** Mavericks forward Max Andreev has been named November's Howies Hockey Tape ECHL Rookie of the Month. Andreev is the first player in team history to win an ECHL Rookie of the Month award.

Andreev, 25, scored four goals and 11 assists for 15 points in 12 games in the first full month of the ECHL season. Andreev had four multi-point games in November, including notching one goal and two assists in the November 10th victory at Allen.
