TODAY – Wichita begins a six-game, 11-day road trip tonight with the first of three-straight against the Idaho Steelheads. Both teams enter tonight's contest on a three-game winning streak. The Thunder knocked off Iowa on Sunday while Idaho beat Utah last Saturday at the Maverik Center. Wichita and Idaho are tied for second in the Mountain Division with six points. The Thunder only plays Idaho three times all season, which happens to be this week. Mark Russell and Keaton Mastrodonato lead the Steelheads with six points each. Colton Kehler, A.J. White, Wade Murphy and Cody Haiskanen each have four. Brayden Watts leads the Thunder with 10 points. Jay Dickman and Bradley Marek are second with seven.

HEAD-TO-HEAD – This is the first meeting of the season between the Thunder and the Steelheads. All-time, Wichita is 12-12-5 against Idaho and 3-8-2 on the road against the Steelheads.

100 – Brayden Watts had a big week for the Thunder. The fourth-year forward had three helpers on Friday and followed that up with a goal and an assist in back-to-back games. Watts netted his 100th-career assist on Saturday night. He finished with two goals and five helpers in three wins. Watts is tied second with 10 points.

BULLDOG – Bradley Marek recorded his first game-winner of his career on Sunday afternoon. He scored the go-ahead goal with 55 seconds left to make it a 3-2 game. Marek is tied for sixth in goals (4) and tied for 12th in scoring with seven points.

BIG JAY – Jay Dickman has five points in his last three games. He recorded two power play goals on Friday and followed that up with a goal and two helpers on Sunday afternoon. Dickman is also tied for 11th in scoring with seven points.

FIRSTS – Roman Kinal, Ryan Finnegan, Dillon Boucher and Xavier Pouliot all tallied their first professional goals this past week. Roman Kinal and Ryan Finnegan scored on Tuesday night in Kansas City. Pouliot recorded the game-winner on Friday night against Cincinnati.

MEECH – After being held without a point in his first three games, Michal Stinil has four over his last three contests (2g, 2a). He has assists in back-to-back games. Stinil led the Thunder with 79 points last season.

WARMING UP – Beck Warm claimed two wins over the weekend. He made 35 saves on Friday night and followed that up with a 32-save performance on Sunday. Warm has made 30 or more saves in three of his first four starts this year. Last season, he won 28 games with Cincinnati.

BIO: Masella is entering his second full season as a pro. He joined Kalamazoo in 2021-22 after appearing in eight games at Carleton University (USports). The Phoenix, Arizona native played in 20 games that year for the Wings, netting four points (1g, 3a).

Last season, Masella signed with Kalamazoo and saw action in 29 games. He was dealt to the Savannah Ghost Pirates in February and played in nine contests. The 6-foot-5, 220-pound blueliner also played in eight games for the SPHL's Evansville Thunderbolts. Masella recorded six points (3g,3a) over that stretch.

He was named to the France2 All-Star Team and scored the most goals in the league by a defenseman.

BIO: Ramsay is in his fifth year behind the Thunder bench and has compiled a record of 125-122-32. He was named ECHL Coach of the Year during the 2020-21 campaign and was instrumental in helping develop current Edmonton Oilers netminder Stuart Skinner, defenseman Vincent Desharnais, and Toronto Maple Leafs forward Bobby McMann. Both McMann and Desharnais made their NHL debuts this season.

Last year, he hit two big plateaus as a head coach, claiming his 500th win on February 16 against Idaho and coaching his 1,000th game on January 4 against the Steelheads.

A native of Dryden, Ontario, Ramsay played for the Thunder during the 2000-01 season, racking up 364 penalty minutes.
