Legally required postings translated in Spanish, Vietnamese and Chinese:

Language assistance sign is posted near the entrance in vote centers that identifies the languages spoken by the election workers at that location. (The language of the sign is translated.)

Election Workers and/or Vote Center Coordinators who speak an alternate language write that language on their name tag (in the text of that language).

Translated ballot sign is displayed at each voter check-in station.

Translated copies of the ballot are displayed at voter check-in stations, and additional copies are available upon request.

"Elections in California Notice" is posted inside the voting room.

"Prohibition of Electioneering" sign is posted outside vote center entrance.

California Voter Information Guides are displayed at voter check-in stations.

"Voter's Bill of Rights" sign is posted outside the vote center entrance.

Additional translated language materials at vote centers:

Voter registration forms are displayed at check-in stations (3% languages).

Easy Voter Guides are displayed at check-in stations (3% languages).

Voting booths have instructions that show how to mark a ballot (Spanish only).

"Vote Here" stand-up sign is displayed outside vote center (Spanish only).

Our recruitment notice and Voter Information Guide includes a request for bi-lingual workers in Spanish and Vietnamese and Chinese.
