This service covers all Placer County mandated languages, and at least 93 total languages/dialects are provided. This method was selected in ADDITION to staffing translators at our precincts, to ensure we provide the best service to our voters with lanugage needs, and to allow our office staff to communicate with ESL voters if they need service before election day.
