Stanislaus County utilizes the Telephone Interpreter Service offered through the Secretary of State. Each vote center as well as the main elections office has access to a telephone. This phone can be utilized to call the Telephone Interpreter Service so voters can be assisted in whatever language they request (over 70 languages are covered by this service).

This service was not requested by voters during the November 2022 General Election.

Stanislaus County made good faith efforts to recruit poll workers bilingual in the Spanish, Khmer, Punjabi, and Assyrian (Syriac) languages. The need for bilingual poll workers is advertised on the Stanislaus County Registrar of Voters website. Staff attended outreach events in the community where they advertised the need for bilingual poll workers. Additionally, Stanislaus County has a LAAC (Language Accessibility Advisory Committee) and asked members for assistance in recruiting bilingual election workers.
