

Funding for Problem Gambling

Before the New Law

After the New Law

The Connecticut Lottery was required to make annual payments of 2.3 million dollars into the Chronic Gambler Rehabilitation Fund.

The Lottery is now required to make an additional 1 million dollar payment bringing their total contribution to the fund to 3.3 million.

Mohegan Sun and Foxwoods made voluntary contributions to certain problem gambling programs including The Connecticut Council on Problem Gambling.

Mohegan Sun and Foxwoods are each required to make contributions of \$500,000 to certain problem gambling programs or accounts.

General Funding Contributions

The new law requires monthly payments from Mohegan Sun, Foxwoods, and the Connecticut Lottery to the General Fund ranging from 13.75% to 20% of gross revenues from sports wagering, online casino gaming, and fantasy contests.

Proposed Joint Tribal Casino in East Windsor

The new law delays the previous authorization for the casino for a period of 10 years.
