Curious about the life cycle of the salmon of the Little North Fork Noyo River?

CDFW have three monitoring stations where intensive lifecycle monitoring takes place. The data gathered there is used to inform the rest of the salmon surveying in the region.

- What can be done to restore salmon habitat in our local rivers?
