



### Whitefish and Cisco Sport Gill Netting Regulations (Whitefish netting license required)

- Whitefish and Cisco (also known as Tullibee) netting is open to Minnesota residents only.
- Participants must be in possession of a valid Minnesota angling license and the \$10 netting license.
- Only one gill net, not exceeding 100 feet in length and 3 feet in width may be used by a netter at any given time.
- One end of net must have a pole, stake, or buoy projecting at least two feet above the water or ice surface.
- Nets must have an identification tag attached near the first float of the end projecting from the water/ice.
- Identification tags must be at least 2½ inches by 5/8 inch permanently bearing net owner's name and address.
- Nets may not be set or lifted between sunset and sunrise.
- All gill nets must be tended at least every 24 hours and can only be set and lifted by the licensee.
- Nets may not be set in any water deeper than six feet and cannot be set within 50 feet of another net.
- Minimum gill net mesh size varies among lakes – be sure to check the attached schedules.
- A person may not have angling equipment in possession while netting.
- Rough fish, as defined by Minnesota Statute 97A.015, Subd. 43, caught in the net may be retained. All other non-target fish taken while netting must be returned to the water immediately.
- Nets used in waters infested by spiny water fleas and/or zebra mussels may not be used in any other waters.
- Additional lakes now have net restrictions due to spiny water flea and/or zebra mussel presence. Please be sure to verify if net restrictions apply to any lake you plan to net.
- Nets used in waters designated infested by other species (not spiny water fleas and/or zebra mussels) must be dried for a minimum of 10 days or frozen for 2 days before using in a different water body.
- Please verify if the lake you plan to net is designated as infested. The full list of infested waters can be found at <https://www.dnr.state.mn.us/invasives/ais/infested.html>.
- Nets should be transported in sealed container.
- Whitefish and Cisco taken by sport gill netting may not be bought, sold, or used as bait.
- Within the Leech Lake Reservation, the possession limits are 25 whitefish and 50 cisco.
- Net placement should not inhibit use of the lake by other boaters.

## Seasons Open for Taking Whitefish and Cisco by Netting Schedules Designating Open Seasons for Certain Waters

Please refer to the following pages for waters that will, or may, be open to Whitefish and Cisco netting this year. The waters listed in Schedule I may be open this year. Net harvest allowances in Schedule I lakes varies from year-to-year based on assessments of game fish abundance, climatic conditions that affect the vulnerability of game fish to accidental harvest, and abundance of Whitefish and Cisco. Schedule II water bodies exhibit less variability and are therefore opened and closed on a pre-determined schedule. Unless otherwise noted, the names of the bodies of water refer to lakes.

### Schedule I Water Bodies

All water bodies listed in this schedule are to be opened and closed on a 48 hour notice posted at the lake accesses and other public places. Lakes in **bold** and marked with asterisk (\*) are designated infested with spiny water fleas and/or zebra mussels (see footnote about net use in these lakes). The table below indicates the minimum mesh size (based on stretch measures) allowed on each lake.

## Schedule II Water Bodies

Schedule II waters are open based on one of three netting schedules listed below. Netting period designations (A, B, and C) are defined below and designated as “Open Dates” in the following table. Lakes in **bold** and marked with asterisk (\*) are designated infested with spiny water fleas and/or zebra mussels (see footnote about net use in these lakes). The table below indicates the minimum mesh size allowed (based on stretch measures) on each lake.

A = Open second Friday of October through First Sunday of December **(Oct. 13, 2023 to Dec. 3, 2023)**

B = Open first Friday of November through second Sunday of December **(Nov. 3, 2023 to Dec. 10, 2023)**

C = Open second Friday of November through second Sunday of December **(Nov. 10, 2023 to Dec. 10, 2023)**
